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PRELIMINARY 1980 CENSUS COUNTS OF POPULATION AND HOUSING

Preliminary counts of population and housing stock for the counties and municipalities of New Jersey are presented in this report. The population figures are total counts, including both the household population and the group quarters population. The housing counts include seasonal and year-round units, both occupied and vacant.

The preliminary counts, compiled from the tallies made by the Census Bureau's district offices, are the first information published from the 1980 Census. The data presented here will be published by the Census Bureau in the series PHC(P) reports, Preliminary Population and Housing Unit Counts.

The final certified census counts will be tabulated directly from the census questionnaires at the Census Bureau's three Regional Processing Centers. The final counts are scheduled for release in the Spring of 1981 and will be available in reports published both by this office and the Census Bureau.

Changes Since 1970

The census figures show that New Jersey grew very slowly during the decade, increasing by only 164,696 persons, or 2.3%. In contrast, several counties showed substantial increases while others had significant declines. The largest gain was in Ocean County whose population increased by more than 135,000 persons, or 65.0%. Three counties gained more than 30,000 each: Sussex gained 38,590 (49.8%); Burlington, 37,692 (11.7%); and Monmouth, 34,464 (7.5%). In addition, Cape May and Hunterdon counties, although their absolute increases were not as large, grew by 37.8% and 24.9%, respectively. Losses were reported in five northern counties: Essex declined by 83,557 persons (9.0%); Bergen, 52,900 (5.9%); Hudson, 52,361 (8.6%); Union, 40,652 (7.5); and Passaic, 13,084 (2.8%).

Housing stock increased more than population during the decade. The state gained 386,832 units, a 16.2% increase. The five counties showing the largest numerical increases were: Ocean, 62,378 units (56.5%); Monmouth, 41,404 units (28.8%); Burlington, 32,540 units (36.9%); Middlesex, 31,850 units (18.5%) and Camden, 30,315 units (22.2%). No county declined in housing stock during the decade. The five counties with the smallest numerical increases were: Essex, 3,659 (1.2%); Salem, 4,580 (23.4%); Warren, 6,373 (25.5%); Passaic, 7,043 (4.6%); and Hudson, 7,091 (3.3%).
