### UPDATES TO MODEL CRIMINAL JURY CHARGES

The Supreme Court Committee on Model Criminal Jury Charges has issued the following Model Criminal Jury Charges. **Non-2C Charge**

**Redacted Recorded Statement of Defendant (10/6/14)**

This is a new charge.

**2C:13-1a, b(1) to (3),  
and b(4)**

**Kidnapping (10/6/14)**

These three charges were revised to add that if the State is contending that the victim suffered emotional or psychological harm, it must prove that the victim suffered substantial or enduring emotional or psychological harm. See State v. Sherman, 367 N.J. Super. 324, 330 (App. Div. 2004), certif. denied, 180 N.J. 356 (2004).

**2C:24-4b(3), b(4),  
b(5)(a)(i-iii), b(5)(b)**

**Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Pornography (9/8/14)**

These six new charges were drafted in accordance with statutory amendments, effective August 14, 2013. These charges should only be used for crimes committed after August 14, 2013.

**2C:39-3a**

**Possession of a Destructive Device (9/8/14)**

This is a new charge.

**2C:39-5f**

**Possession of an Assault Firearm (10/6/14)**

This charge was revised to include the types of assault firearms and the definitions for "substantially identical."

**2C:40-26**

**Driving while License is Suspended or Revoked for DWI or  
Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Breath Test (10/30/14)**

This charge was revised to add footnote 3 citing to N.J.S.A. 39:4-50 and footnote 4 citing to N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.4a.
