Comparing counts for February 28, 1999 with those on February 28, 1998, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

10% increase	from	28,096	to	30,939	for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
8% increase	from	4,037	to	4,378	for state inmates in county facilities;
14% increase	from	19,126	to	21,862	for the prison complex;
-5% decrease	from	4,933	to	4,699	for the youth facilities.

-4% decrease	from	1,407	to	1,350	for total admissions.

RELEASES

-11% decrease	from	1,087	to	966	for total releases;
-33% decrease	from	705	to	469	for male parole releases;
-15% decrease	from	81	to	69	for female parole releases;
-32% decrease	from	786	to	538	for total parole releases;
23% increase	from	301	to	369	for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
