

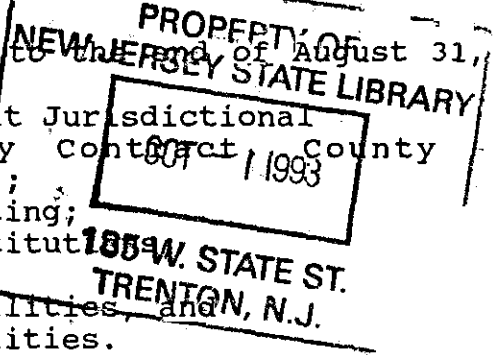

ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS
AUGUST 1993

Compared to the trimester ending August 31, 1992 Parole Releases for trimester ending August 31, 1993 were:

- Down 26% from 1875 to 1387 for the Prison;
- Down 17% from 197 to 164 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility;
- Down 16% from 759 to 641 for the Youth Complex; and
- Down 13% from 140 to 122 for Juvenile Facilities.

Resident counts on August 31, 1993 compared to the end of August 31, 1992 were:

- Down 2% from 23,076 to 22,711 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Correctional County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Down 11% from 3378 to 2985 for County Waiting;
- Down 2% from 23,684 to 23,325 for all Institutions;
- Down from 14,040 to 14,012 for the Prison;
- Up 1% from 4797 to 4821 for the Youth Facilities; and
- Down 2% from 594 to 581 for Juvenile Facilities.



NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ **PAROLE RELEASES** are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ **MEDIUM/MAX UNITS:** Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
