Purpose for Which Funds will be Used: The New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL) (“LiLA Program Owner”) is managing the execution of a two-year pilot to fund the training of unemployed and employed low-income individuals without other degrees or credentials. It is anticipated that recipients will receive up to \$9600 per person to pay for: 1) training, and 2) wraparound services, such as childcare and transportation, that may be necessary to complete their education and training programs. Recipients will work with a career coach to develop an Individual Employment Plan (IEP) to develop and manage the utilization of their LiLA funding and support their success.

Grant funds will be awarded to successful applicants responding to this competitive Notice of Grant Opportunity (NGO). Successful respondents to this NGO will be responsible for managing the recruitment, selection, onboarding and coaching of program participants.
