Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

September passenger traffic grew 6.2%, led by 8.2% international to 5.2% domestic growth. Passenger flights rose in line with passengers, up 8% for international to 5.8% for domestic service. It is no surprise that JFK led the region in passenger growth, up 12% on 12% more flight activity. Regional freight continues soft, down (5.1%).
