A proficiency rate is calculated by summing the count of students who scored either proficient or advanced proficient on the assessment

and dividing by the count of valid test scores.

College and Career Readiness

This school outperforms 21% of schools statewide as noted by its statewide percentile and 28% of schools educating students with similar demographic characteristics as noted in its peer school percentile in the performance area of College and Career Readiness. Additionally, this school is meeting 0% of its performance targets in the area of College and Career Readiness.























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



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








Chronic Absenteeism Trend
