Comparing counts for January 31, 1999 with those on January 31, 1998, the following changes are noted:

**RESIDENTS**

10% increase	from	27,776	to	30,555	for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
2% increase	from	3,919	to	3,997	for state inmates in county facilities;
16% increase	from	18,911	to	21,843	for the prison complex;
-5% decrease	from	4,946	to	4,715	for the youth facilities.

**ADMISSIONS**

1% increase from 1,189 to 1,202 for total admissions.

**RELEASES**

-8% decrease	from	1,169	to	1,081	for total releases;
-25% decrease	from	801	to	604	for male parole releases;
-46% decrease	from	84	to	45	for female parole releases;
-27% decrease	from	885	to	649	for total parole releases;
29% increase	from	284	to	365	for offenders discharged at max.

**NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
