#### NEW JERSEY LEGISLATIVE APPORTIONMENT

#### AN EXPLANATION

The 40 legislative districts outlined in this booklet were drawn by the Apportionment Commission following the 1980 Census. Strict numerical equality is the most significant factor used by the Commission in creating the districts. One Senator and two Assembly members are elected from each district. The present plan was adopted on April 13, 1981, for the legislative terms beginning on January 12, 1982. These legislative districts will remain in effect, barring a court decision, until the next decennial census in 1990.

#### A HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

The New Jersey Constitution of 1776-which predated the Federal Constitution-provided for a bicameral Legislature, including an Upper House composed of one member from each county regardless of population and a Lower House with each county guaranteed three members and additional members authorized to be apportioned on the basis of population. The Constitutions of 1844 and 1947 retained the one Senator per county provision and provided for a General Assembly of not more than 60 members to be apportioned among the counties "as nearly as may be" according to population, with each county guaranteed at least one member regardless of its population.

In 1964, the New Jersey Supreme Court ruled that the Senate, which had been composed of one Senator from each county for 189 years, violated the "one man, one vote" principle laid down by the United States Supreme Court under the equal protection clause of the 14th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States and that, therefore, the entire Legislature was invalid. The Court ordered that a properly apportioned, interim Legislature, to sit in 1966 and 1967, be established by law pending the establishment of a permanent new Legislature.

In 1966, a Constitutional Convention proposed a constitutional amendment providing for a bicameral Legislature of 40 Senators and 80 Assembly members. In November of that year, the people approved the Convention's proposals, which delineated 15 Senate districts and apportioned the 40 Senators among them and created a bipartisan Apportionment Commission to subdivide the Senate districts into Assembly districts for use in the 1967 and 1969 elections and, following future Federal censuses, to establish both Senate and Assembly districts.

In a series of court challenges, the New Jersey Supreme Court ordered various changes in the Senate and General Assembly districts certified by the Apportionment Commission, later ruled that the State constitutional provisions calling for Senate districts composed of whole counties could not meet the Federal equal-population standards, and directed the Apportionment Commission to divide the State into 40 equal-population legislative districts. The court ordered that the districts be composed, wherever practicable, of whole contiguous municipalities and that there shall be elected one Senator and two Assembly members from each district.

Following the 1970 census, the Apportionment Commission certified 40 such legislative districts, which, with one modification, were approved by the New Jersey Supreme Court for use in the 1973 and subsequent elections until the promulgation of the 1980 census.

#### LEGISLATIVE APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION

The Apportionment Commission created under Article IV, Section III, of the State Constitution consists of 10 members, five each appointed by the state chairmen of the two major parties. Its mandate is to produce an apportionment plan by February 1, of the year following the Federal decennial census, or within one month after receipt of the census figures, whichever date is later. If the Commission fails to meet its deadline or declares itself deadlocked before then, the Chief Justice appoints an 11th member. The Commission then must produce a plan within a month from the appointment of the 11th member.





# SUBDIVISION OF NORTHEASTERN NEW JERSEY




# SUBDIVISION OF SOUTHWESTERN NEW JERSEY


