Governor to Visit Somerset County Farm to Tour Crops Seniors Will See Tax Relief to be Announced In Toms River

Gov. Chrisite Whitman and New Jersey Agriculture Secretary Art Brown will tour grain fields at River Lea Farm in Branchburg, Somerset County with farm owners Dave and Paula Kanach to discuss the potential for federal natural disaster assistance.

Following the farm tour, the Governor will be at Greenbriar Woodland, an adult community in Toms River, to sign legislation to give significant tax relief to New Jersey senior citizens and individuals with disabilities, allowing them to double the amount of income excluded from the New Jersey Gross Income tax.

She also will stop in Leisure Village West in Manchester and Leisure Village Original in Toms River to visit area residents and discuss issues of concern to them.
