This statewide *Substance Abuse Overview* provides statistics on substance abuse treatment in New Jersey for calendar year 2013. In 2013 there were 75,558 treatment admissions and 72,627 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. These reports were submitted through the web-based New Jersey Substance Abuse Monitoring System (NJ-SAMS). A few changes in this report now include the separation of primary drug heroin from other opiates, and two new tables of 'First Time Clients Admitted by County of Residence and Primary Drug', and 'Admissions by Age Group, Gender, Primary Drug'.


