3. Project: Route 29, FW Section 11, Parcel TBD, Block: 11401, Lots: 1.01 & 2.01, Tax Map #114, City of Trenton, Mercer County

Requesting Party: The NJDOT is requesting approval for the sale of NJDOT owned excess land acquired as Route 29 FW, Section 11, portions of Parcels 189 through 220 and 21L, located in the City of Trenton, Mercer County, (Parcel TBD), to the County of Mercer. The property is approximately 1.094 (+-) acres, or 47,655 (+-) square feet of vacant land identified as Block 11401, Lots 1.01 and 2.01. Title has been vested in the State of New Jersey for more than 10 years. The property was reviewed by various subject matter experts within the Department and deemed to be of no further use to the Department.

Terms: The property will be conveyed to the County of Mercer for the sum of \$1.00, which is in compliance with NJ Legislature Bill 5857 and the Appropriations Act. The property is to be used for public parking only. Upon approval by the State House Commission, the County of Mercer will submit the final General Property Parcel Map (GPPM) and parcel descriptions in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement between the County and NJDOT, and in compliance with NJDOT standards.
