Transcript:

Senate President Sweeney: An empty oil field that's going to be a port and putting so many people to work gives you such a sense of fulfillment. But it couldn't happen if we didn't have a partnership here, so I want to thank the Governor for his willingness not to walk away from Paulsboro, but to invest in Paulsboro because investing in Paulsboro is investing in the people of the state of New Jersey.
