It contains a complete list of construction permit applications filed with or acted upon by D.E.P. Interested persons will thus be able to determine the status of applications dealing with Riparian permits, Wetlands permits, Stream Encroachment permits, Sewerage Extension permits, and CAFRA permits (Coastal Area Facility Review Act). In addition the circular provides a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings. (The Public Hearings however, are not official DEP notices). Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the week are also shown.

#### A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the <u>Governor's Executive Order # 57</u> the <u>Office of Business Advocacy</u> as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expediters in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expeditor to your project. The Permit Expeditor will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

#### **OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS**

#### STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. #### IL RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

## II. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) -292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

## DEP RECAP

May 14—RELAY OF CLAMS TO CLEAN WATERS TO BEGIN-DEP announced the May 21 start of relaying hard clams from polluted waters in Atlantic and Cape May counties to clean waters. Initial relays will be to Tuckerton Cove and the Great Bay area. The relay is expected to continue through October. May T5-HISTORIC SITES RULES HEARING--Proposed regulations for handling nominations of sites for inclusion in the New Jersey Register of Historic Places will undergo a DEP public hearing at 10 a.m., May 29, in the State Museum Auditorium, 205 W. May 15—MEETINGS TO EXPLAIN LAND ACQUISITION PRIORITY PLAN—DEP will hold three informational meetings to explain a proposed system of establishing priorities for open space acquisitions. Meetings are: May 22, Stockton State College, Pomona; May 23, Rutgers University, Cook College Food-Science Building Auditorium. College Farm Road, New Brunswick, and May 24, Parsippany High School auditorium Vail and Baldwin roads, Parsippany. May 15--DEP ORDERS HALT TO PENNSVILLE SEWER EXTENSIONS--A halt to new sewer extensions by the Pennsville Sewerage Authority was ordered by DEP because of overtaxed wastewater treatment facilities resulting in inadequately treated sewage discharges into the Delaware River.

May 15-GYPSY MOTH SPRAYING IN STATE-OWNED PARKS, FORESTS--DEP, in cooperation with the U.S. Forest Service, has targeted about 19,000 acres of gypsy moth-infested land in state parks and forests in northern New Jersey for aerial spraying with the pesticide, Sevin 4-H oil. Research is continuing to find an alternative mode of suppression for use next year.

May 16--CAFRA PERMIT DENIED IN HIGHLANDS--DEP has denied a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit sought by Black Brothers Construction Co., of Highlands, for a proposed 40-unit motel and restaurant and eight two-story condominiums at Martel and Connors avenues in Highlands. Denial stemmed from continued overloading of the Highlands wastewater treatment plant, resulting in discharges of raw sewage into the Shrewsbury River.

May I6--GRAHAM CITES TRANSIT NEED IN ATLANTIC CITY--Addressing the Atlantic City Hotel-Motel Association on "State Environmental Perspectives on Atlantic City's Development," Donald T. Graham, director of DEP's Division of Marine Services, stressed the need for careful transit planning amid the growing casino industry and resulting traffic increases in the city. Warning that a glut of individual cars can result in localized air pollution, Graham described various plans for possible new transit modes such as shuttle buses from remote parking lots, both for casino customers and employees alike.

May 16-SHELLFISHING AREAS INCREASED BY OVER 7,000 ACRES-DEP reclassified 7,261 acres as approved for shellfishing, bringing the total of approved waters to 153,265 acres within New Jersey's three-mile jurisdiction. Improvements are at Teast partially due to construction of new sewage treatment facilities. Charts delineating approved and condemned shellfish harvesting areas are available at the Division of Water Resources, Box CN-029, Trenton, NJ 08625, and from harvest license agents. May 16--PINELANDS COMMISSION MEETINGS SET--The Pinelands Planning Commission will meet May 17 at 7:30 p.m. in the Holiday Inn. Route 37, Toms River, and May 18 at 9 a.m. at Ocean County College.

May 16—CHEMICAL CONTROL PRESS CONFERENCE—Dr. GTenm Paulson, assistant DEP commissioner for science, and Karl Birns, chief of DEP's Office of Hazardous Substances Control, held a press conference in Trenton to describe progress of cleanup at the Chemical Control Corporation, Elizabeth.

May IT--RESOURCE RECOVERY WORKSHOP SLATED--Source separation of recyclables will be outlined June 26 in New Brunswick at a municipal material recovery workshop co-sponsored by the state Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), state Department of Energy (DOE), and the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The workshop will be in the Ramada Inn, Route 18. It is designed for local officials and public interest groups. A \$20 registration fee covers lunch and materials. May 18-JULY 4 "CLEAN AIR RUNS" IN PINELANDS-DEP has endorsed a symbolic 10,000-meter (6.2-mile) "Clean Air Run" sponsored by the Pineland Striders Running Club July 4 starting at 10:30 a.m. at Shawnee High School, Tabernacle Road, Medford. For the less ambitious there will be a two-mile "fun run" starting at the same time. Both races will conclude at the high school, with many prizes. May 18--PINELANDS COMMISSION TO GET \$500,000 GRANT--Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson announced a \$500,000 planning grant from the state to the new Pinelands Planning Commission. The money, from the Green Acres fund, will help the commission begin planning efforts in accordance with Governor Byrne's executive order for protection of the ecologically sensitive pines region, Wilson said. She added that the money also will help establish priorities for land acquisition, obtaining easements, and other efforts to protect the
