RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
MAY 1997

Comparing counts for May 31, 1997 with those on May 31, 1996, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 0% increase from 27,257 to 27,265 for the jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- -7% decrease from 4,699 to 4,352 for county waiting;
- -3% decrease from 1,034 to 1001 for county contract and county assistance;
- -6% increase from 16,010 to 17,035 for the prison complex;
- -12% decrease from 5,514 to 4,877 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

- -17% decrease from 1,467 to 1,222 for total admissions.

RELEASES

- 1% increase from 1,520 to 1,542 for total releases;
- 2% increase from 1,103 to 1,123 for male parole releases;
- -27% decrease from 150 to 110 for female parole releases;
- -2% decrease from 1,253 to 1,233 for total parole releases;
- 16% increase from 267 to 309 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.

b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.

c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.
