**NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INCARCERATED PERSONS INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ INCARCERATED PERSONS (IP's) include state sentenced inmates in institutions on the date of this report. Jurisdictional population is the total of state IP's housed in the prison complex, youth facility and in county jails. State offenders in county facilities included in this report are NJ sentenced IP's. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I - community, SL II - minimum, SL III - medium, SL IV - maximum, SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the database each month.
- c/ RELEASES include parole violations and IP's discharged at max. Escapes, and inmates serving out of state sentences are not included. Intensive supervision programs, death, recall, and unspecified discharges are included in the Other Releases category.
- d/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes IP's released upon expiration of maximum sentence and IP's released under the No Early Release Act (NERA). However, IP's released under NERA are supervised by parole: first degree offenses during five years; second degree offenses during three years.
