Court-Authorized Electronic Surveillance

2014

The New Jersey Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance Control Act require the Attorney General to report annually on the use of court-authorized intercepts. To accomplish this, the Act directs the Attorney General to collect and maintain records of all court-authorized intercepts, regardless of whether the intercept is carried out by the Attorney General's Office, a county prosecutor's office, or a local law enforcement agency.

Data reported pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 2A:156A-23* was compiled to report on the operation of the New Jersey Wiretapping Act. As required by statute, this report contains data concerning:

- (1) The number of applications made.
- (2) The number of orders issued.
- (3) The effective periods of such orders.
- (4) The number and duration of any renewals.
- (5) The crime in connection with electronic surveillance orders.
- (6) Indictments resulting from each application.
- (7) The crime which each indictment charges.
- (8) The disposition of each indictment.

In addition to the detailed information provided for 2014 applications and orders, supplemental follow-up data is provided for electronic surveillance orders reported in previous calendar years.

APPLICATIONS

In 2014, 174 applications for electronic surveillance orders were reported statewide pursuant to the Wiretap Act.¹ The applications authorized by prosecution officials are as follows.

¹The Federal AOC and New Jersey Prosecutor's Offices report orders in the year that they are filed. The State Attorney General reports orders in the year that the investigation is completed. Six wires were authorized in the year 2014 by the Attorney General but will not appear in the state report until the investigations are completed.

ORDERS FOR ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE

In all, 174 court orders were entered granting court authorization for electronic surveillance in 2014. Extensions were requested and granted for 39 intercept orders. In addition second extensions were granted in 11 instances.

- Of the 174 orders requesting interception of communication, 86 authorized wire (telephone) intercepts, 46 orders granted both wire and electronic intercepts, 41 authorized electronic intercepts and 1 order granted an oral intercept.

- There were a total of 128 requests for personal cell phones and text communications, 38 for pre-recorded jail conversations, 4 for landlines, 2 for voicemails, 1 for a computer and 1 for microphone recordings.

- Of the 174 orders requesting interception of communications, 167 were installed and utilized, 7 intercepts were never installed.

- Of the 174 orders, 69 authorized use of intercepts for 20 days, 62 for 30 days, 31 for 1 day, 5 for 10 days, 3 for 2 days, 1 for 5 days, 1 for 4 days, 1 for 14 days, and 1 with number of days unknown.

Section 8 of the Wiretap Act specifies the crimes for which electronic surveillance may be granted. Offense data collected and analyzed for court-authorized electronic surveillance consider the most serious offense investigated.

Overall, electronic surveillance orders were granted in connection with investigations involving the following offense categories; arson, assault, burglary, controlled dangerous substance offenses, conspiracy, endangering a child/child abuse, gambling, human trafficking, leader of a narcotics network, manslaughter, money laundering, murder and murder conspiracy, obstructing justice, official misconduct, perjury, racketeering, robbery, weapons violations and witness tampering.

Of the 174 orders authorizing electronic surveillance, the majority, 81 (47%) listed controlled dangerous substance offenses as the most serious offense followed by racketeering 28 (16%) and murder 21 (12%).

DEFENDANT INDICTMENTS AND DISPOSITIONS

Summary information concerning defendant indictments resulting from electronic surveillance applications is provided below.

- In 2014, the 167 'installed and utilized' wires resulted in 375 arrests.
- In 2014, 190 of the 375 defendants were indicted statewide.

At the end of 2014, of the 375 defendants, 306 were awaiting prosecutorial decisions with cases pending. Two defendants were referred to municipal court and 3 were fugitives. Sixty-four defendants indicted reached final disposition.

Of the 64 defendants reaching final disposition, 48 were convicted through guilty pleas, 1 was found guilty at trial and 8 were admitted into a pre-trial intervention program. Seven defendants had their cases dismissed.

MEMORANDUM TO: THE HONORABLE CHRIS CHRISTIE AND THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

The New Jersey Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance Control Act (N.J.S.A. 2A:156A-1 to -34) requires the Chief Justice to submit an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature (N.J.S.A. 2A:156A-23E). In accordance with that section, I am submitting this report to inform you of the operation of the Act during 2014.

N.J.S.A. 2A:156A-2(i) provides that only Superior Court judges designated by the Chief Justice are authorized to hear wiretap applications. For the year 2014, the following judges were authorized wiretap judges: by order dated December 3, 1997, Judge Samuel D. Natal; by order dated July 22, 1999, Judge Marilyn C. Clark; by order dated May 26, 2007, Judge Travis L. Francis and Judge Lawrence M. Lawson; by order dated July 14, 2008, Judge Peter J. Vazquez; by order dated February 1, 2009, Judge Joseph P. Donohue; by order dated February 18, 2009, Judge Peter E. Doyne; by order dated September 1, 2009, Judge Ronald E. Bookbinder, Judge Yolanda Ciccone, Judge Francis R. Hodgson, Jr. and Judge Walter L. Marshall, Jr.; by order dated March 1, 2010, Judge Pedro J. Jimenez, Jr.; by order dated June 1, 2010, Judge Michael A. Donio and Judge Bernard E. DeLury, Jr.; by order dated September 1, 2010, Judge Liliana DeAvila-Silebi; by order dated October 4, 2010, Judge Greta Gooden Brown; by order dated October 3, 2011, Judge Joseph V. Isabella, Judge Sheila A. Venable and Judge Lisa Rose; by order dated March 1, 2012, Judge Mary C. Jacobson; by order dated December 24, 2012, Judge Stuart A. Minkowitz; by order dated May 1, 2014, Judge Ronald D. Wigler; by order dated July 23, 2014, Judge Timothy G. Farrell; and by order dated August 11, 2014, Judge Lisa P. Thornton, Judge Miguel A. de la Carrera and Judge Mitzy Galis-Menendez.

The data for the year 2014 includes reports of all orders granting permission to intercept wire, electronic and/or oral communications, or to perform electronic surveillance, for any period that ended in 2014. It is the actual termination date of the surveillance that governs which reports are included within the reporting year. During 2014, the reports to the Administrative Office of the

Courts reflected 154 applications¹ seeking permission to intercept wire, electronic or oral communications. There was 1 application denied. Thus, in 2014 the authorized judges entered 153 orders granting permission to intercept wire, electronic and/or oral communications.

Of the 153 orders entered, 69 permitted interception of wire communications, 48 permitted interception of electronic communications, and 0 permitted interception of oral communications. In addition, 36 applications were authorized for the retrieval of stored communications, rather than for the interception of wire, electronic and/or oral communications. There were 43 orders authorized for 30 days each, 80 were specified for 20 days each, and 30 others were authorized for less than 20 days each. Additionally, 44 extensions of previously entered orders were granted during the reporting year. Of these, 17 extensions were for 30 days and 1 extension was for 20 days. There were another 26 extensions for 10 days or less.

N.J.S.A. 2A:156A-11 provides that in certain instances a showing of special need is required before an order for interception of wire, electronic and/or oral communication is to be granted. The reports made by the authorized judges indicate that in reporting year 2014, a showing of special need was required in 0 of the orders, a showing was not required in 87 orders, and the special need information was not available in 66 orders.
