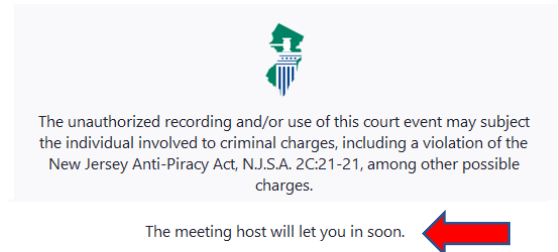


How to view a sign language interpreter in Zoom

These instructions are for a laptop; an iPad has a different appearance.

Join the meeting

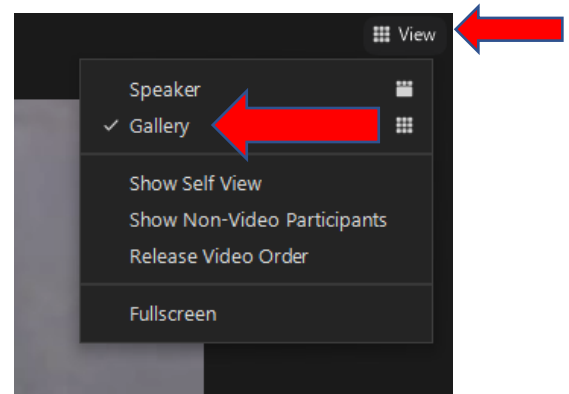
1. Login into Zoom
2. Click the blue link for Zoom meeting or enter the Meeting ID and password numbers.



You may have to wait for the Host to let you in the Zoom courtroom.

When you are allowed in:

3. Find the '**View**' button at the top right of your screen
4. Choose '**Gallery**'



You will see the interpreter and all other people in the court.

The interpreter will tell you which option to use:

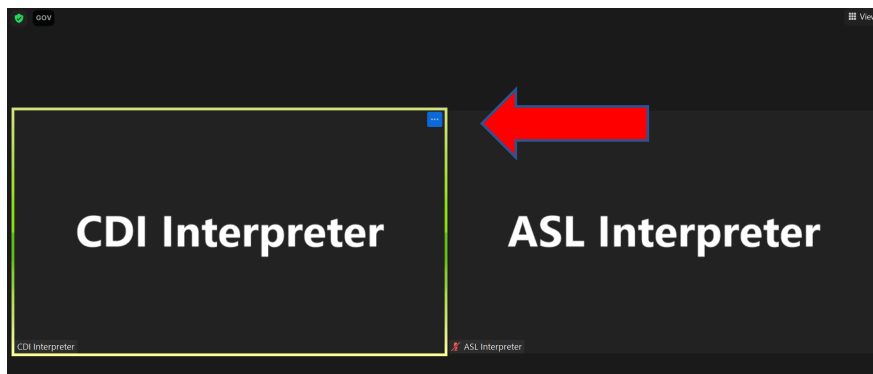
- A. Use 'Pin the Interpreter'
- B. Use 'Interpretation' window

Directions:

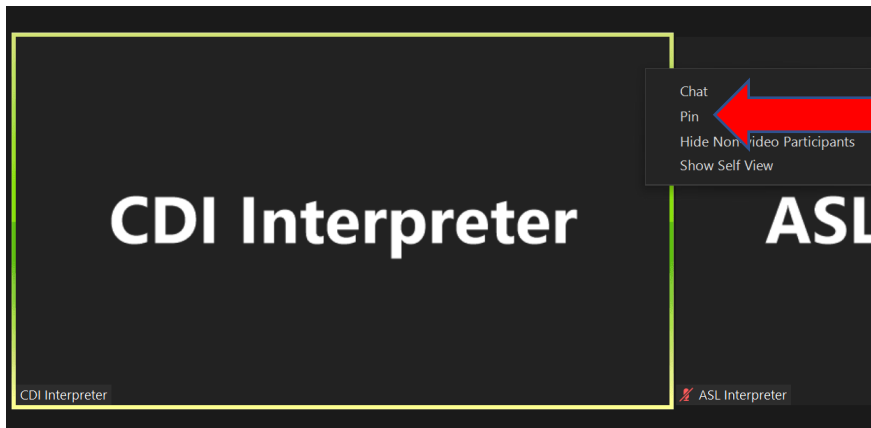
A. How to Pin the Interpreter

1. Look for three blue dots on the CDI box (move to the upper right corner, the dots will appear)

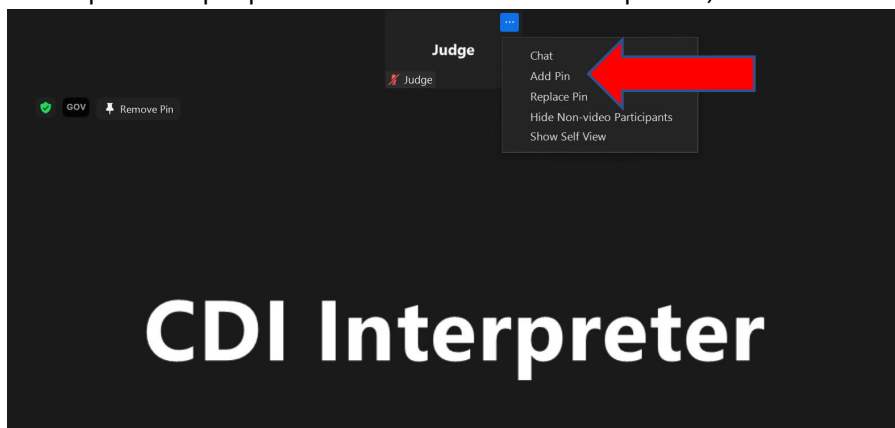
Click on the three blue dots to see a menu list



2. Click on 'Pin'



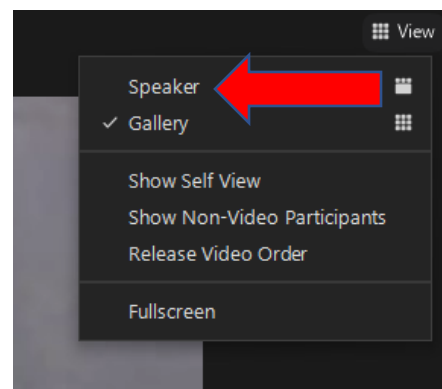
3. You can pin more people. Find the blue dots for that person; click 'Add Pin'



Adjust your preferences

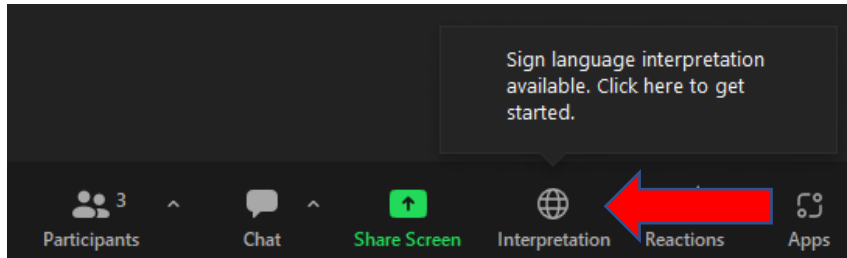
Use the 'View' button at the top right of your screen.

Choose 'Speaker' or 'Gallery' to control your screen layout.

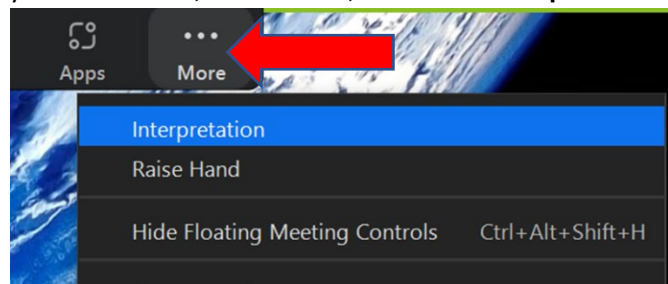


B. How to use the 'Interpretation' window

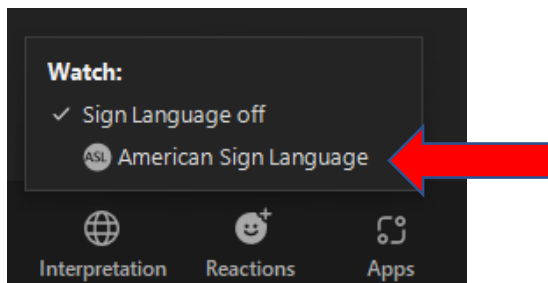
1. At the bottom of the screen, click the 'Interpretation' icon.



Note: If you can't find it, click 'More', then click 'Interpretation'



2. Under Watch, click on 'American Sign Language'



Adjust your preferences
