4. No stopping or standing in Springfield Township, Burlington County along both sides from the Springfield Township—Mansfield Township corporate line to a point 380 feet southerly therefrom.

i. Along both sides:

(1) For the entire length within the corporate limits of Springfield Township including all ramps and connections under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation except at approved bus stops.

5. No stopping or standing in Montgomery Township, Somerset County:

i. Along both sides:

(1) From the northerly curb line of Harlinger Road to a point 285 feet northerly therefrom.
