## **Monthly Traffic Report**

### **Newark Liberty International John F.Kennedy International LaGuardia Stewart International Teterboro & regional satellite airport summaries**

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily)" refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger traffic was little changed from July 2007, down (0.2%), on a 3.5% rise in seat capacity. International led with a 3.4% increase on 5.4% more seats. Domestic traffic slumped (2.0%) on (1.1%) fewer seats. Regional traffic bettered that reported by American Transport Association (ATA) member airlines, which showed a (4.0%) passenger decline, split between a 3.6% international gain and a (5.1%) domestic loss. July Regional freight traffic declined (10.9%).
