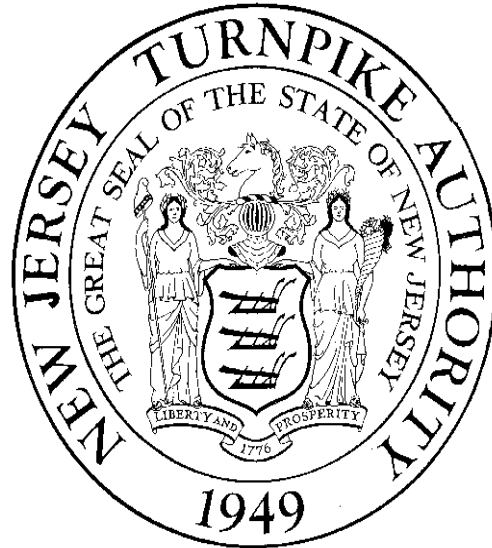

RE: Authorization to enter into an agreement with the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) for the relocation of an NJTA access easement Section 7, Parcel A605

In connection with a NJDOT project involving Routes 1 and 9T, the NJDOT has requested that the Authority relocate one of its access easements that it uses to access its tolls facilities. The Authority has agreed to cooperate with NJDOT to allow transfer of various parcels in furtherance of the Project. NJDOT and the Authority will work cooperatively to identify suitable relocation of an access road which will meet the Authority's needs.

The agreement will require the Authority to transfer various property interests to the NJDOT, and the NJDOT to cause the transfer of certain property interests to the Authority so as to support the NJDOT project in the area of Turnpike Exit 15X relating to Routes 1 and 9T, ultimately resulting in a relocated easement entry onto Authority property. Access to Authority toll facilities for Authority employees will be maintained at all times. The transfers of properties between the Authority and the NJDOT will be pursuant to the agreement between the parties which allows transfers of property between them with total appraised values not to exceed \$500,000 to be transferred at no cost. The NJDOT would obtain or cause to obtain all necessary permits and licenses prior to commencing any work.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the Executive Director be authorized to execute an agreement substantially as set forth above. It is further recommended that the Executive Director be authorized to take such further actions and execute such additional documents as are consistent with the authorizations granted herein.





The low bidder, Carbro Constructors Corp. has performed work for the Authority and is considered competent to complete this contract.

It is, therefore, recommended that Contract No. P200.604 be awarded to the low bidder, Carbro Constructors Corp. of Warren, New Jersey, in the amount of \$10,832,507.00. This award is contingent upon the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey completing the review of all documents submitted by the selected awardee, pursuant to Public Law 2005, Chapter 51 (formerly Executive Order 134) and Executive Order 117 (Corzine 2008), and having no objection to same. Bids for this work were procured, and the authorization being sought is to award this contract to the lowest responsible bidder, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 27:23-6.1, N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.2, and Executive Order No. 37 (Corzine 2006).

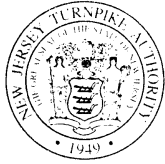

Through this single procurement process the Authority will select two consultants to furnish supervision of construction services for Contract Nos. P500.725 and T500.643-1.

OPS No. T4111 will provide supervision of construction services for Contract No. P500.725, Construction of Pre-Engineered Metal Building Trades Shop at Barnegat Tolls, Milepost 68.94 NB. OPS No. T4112 will provide supervision of construction services for Contract No. T500.643-1, Roof Replacement at Interchange 14 Toll Canopy and TMD6 Landscape Shop. These services will include construction inspection, material testing, record keeping, preparation of payment estimates, and other services required to ensure compliance with the contract documents.

These assignments are classified as "Simple Projects" since the scopes of work are clearly defined and not likely to change during the course of the project, and the cost of each is less than \$2,000,000.00. The Solicitation for Expressions of Interest (EOIs) was posted on the Authority's website and forty-six (46) engineering firms were prequalified and eligible under Profile Codes: B151, Construction Management and B159, Building Construction & Renovations Inspection. Three firms submitted EOIs by the closing date of January 20, 2023.

The scoring of the EOIs by the Review Committee resulted in the following order of ranking of the three firms: 1) KS Engineers, P.C.; 2) Colliers Engineering & Design, Inc.; and 3) Gannett Fleming, Inc. The three firms were requested to submit sealed Fee Proposals, which were received and have been reviewed. The Fee Proposal of the highest technically ranked firm, KS Engineers, P.C., for OPS No. P4111 (their preferred OPS) was negotiated and revised, which resulted in a reduction of their original Fee Proposal. Subsequently, a review of the Fee Proposal of the second highest technically ranked firm, Colliers Engineering & Design, Inc., for OPS No. T4112 resulted in acceptance of their original Fee Proposal. Both fees are considered to be fair and reasonable for the services to be provided.

It is, therefore, recommended that Order for Professional Services No. P4111 be issued to the firm of KS Engineers, P.C. of Mount Laurel, New Jersey, not to exceed the amount of \$430,000.00. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.25 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

It is further recommended that Order for Professional Services No. T4112 be issued to the firm of Colliers Engineering & Design, Inc. of Red Bank, New Jersey not to exceed the amount of \$390,000.00. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.35 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

The issuance of these OPS' are contingent upon the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey completing the review of all documents submitted by the selected awardees, pursuant to Public Law 2005, Chapter 51 (formerly Executive Order 134) and Executive Order 117 (Corzine 2008), and having no objection to same. These professional services were procured, and the recommended firms were selected, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:34-9.1, et seq., N.J.S.A. 27:23-6.1 of the Authority's enabling legislation, N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.8, promulgated pursuant thereto, and Executive Order No. 37 (Corzine 2006).

This Order for Professional Services was issued at the October 26, 2021 Commission Meeting, in the amount of \$1,361,000.00. It provides for design services for bridge inspection, condition evaluation and preparation of contract documents for bridge deck repairs, resurfacing and miscellaneous structural repairs on the southern portion of the Turnpike.

Supplement A will provide for emergency inspection, fast-track design and post-design services which are beyond the current authorized scope of work for the repair of damage to structural steel caused by an over height vehicle impact to Turnpike Str. No. 60.51B (Int. 7A Ramps ET/TW over I-195). The requested work includes the issuance of a Change of Plan (COP) to Contract No. T100.560 for the performance of the repairs. Figure 1 - New Jersey Turnpike Vehicle Mileage Traveled and Total Crash Rate by Month

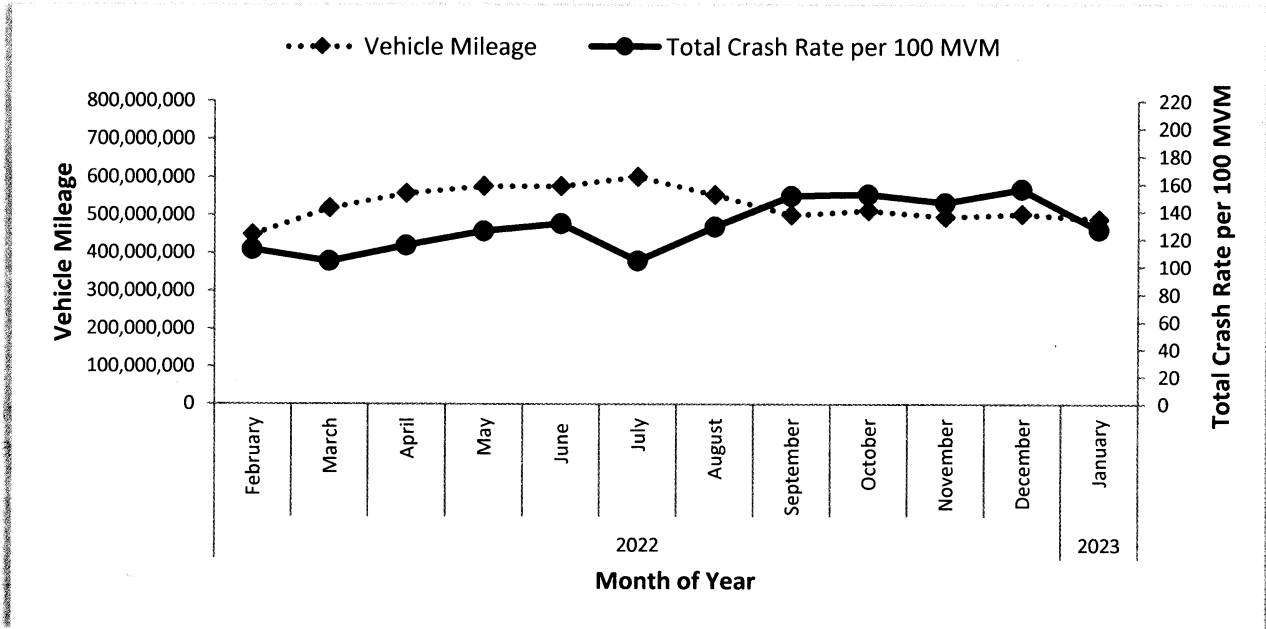
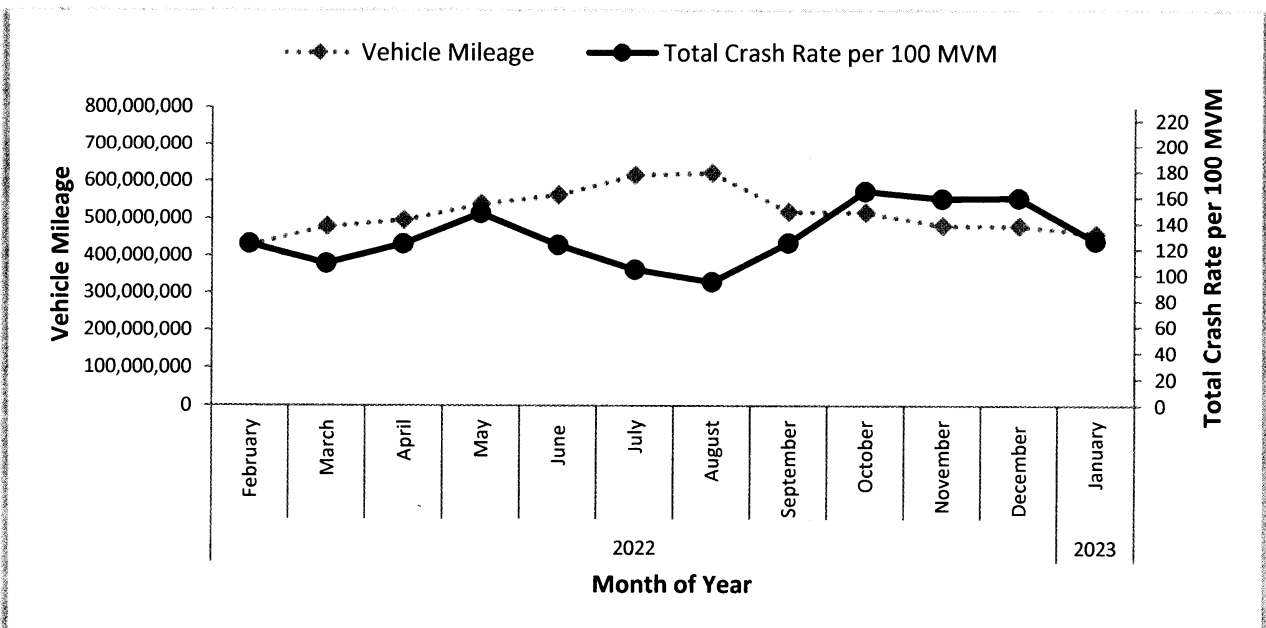


Figure 2 - Garden State Parkway Vehicle Mileage Traveled and Total Crash Rate by Month

Figure 3 - New Jersey Turnpike Injury and Property-Damage-Only Crashes by Month

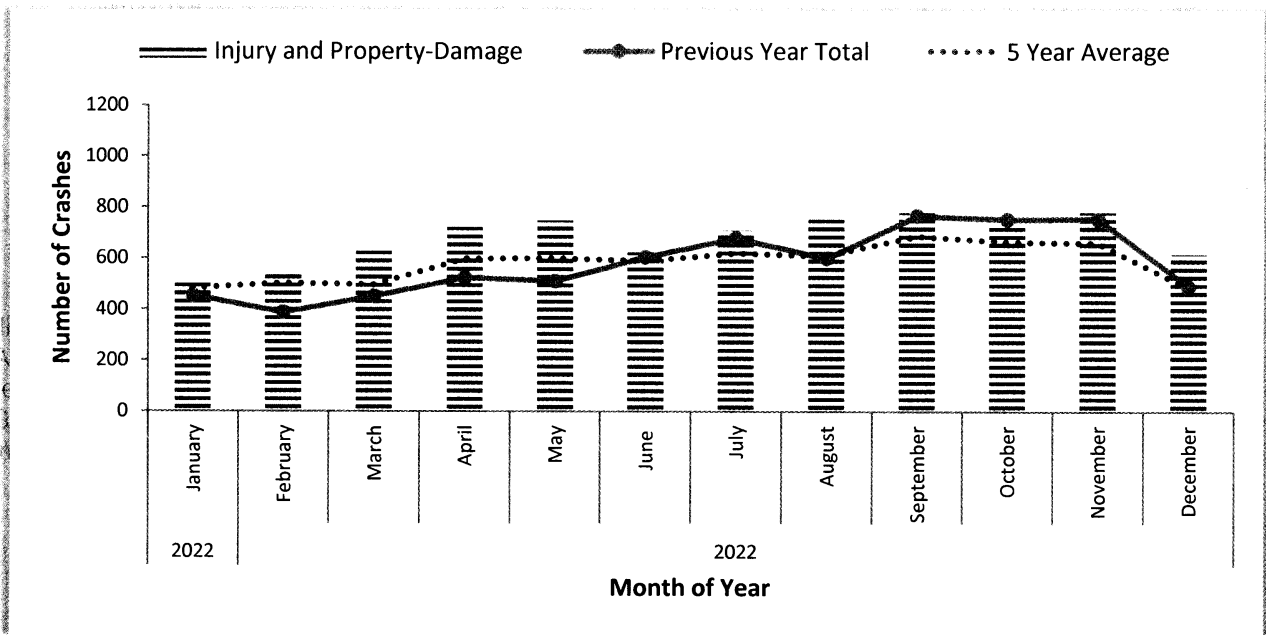
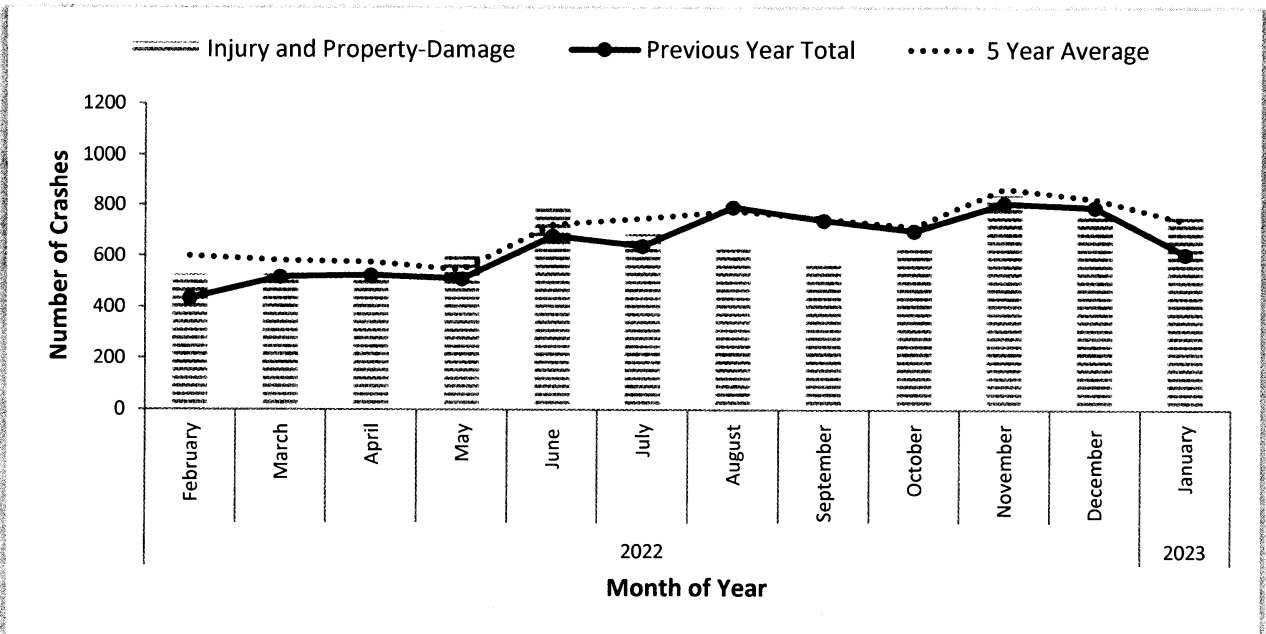


Figure 4 - Garden State Parkway Injury and Property-Damage-Only Crashes by Month

The Transportation Operations Coordinating Committee (“Transcom”) is an organization which provides a forum for the reconciliation of operating procedures, improved agency communications and the coordination of construction projects within the metropolitan area. Under Agenda Item No. 108-04-2018, the Board approved the Authority’s membership in Transcom through December 31, 2023. Membership in Transcom helps the New Jersey Turnpike Authority ensure the mobility and safety of its traveling public through the tri-state area via enhanced communication and utilization of the member agencies’ existing traffic and transportation management systems.


The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") utilizes the services of approximately 80 first aid squads and 80 fire departments that are on-call and provide emergency services to the Authority's patrons on the New Jersey Turnpike and the Garden State Parkway. These organizations are further supported by other organizations in a mutual aid capacity. As the owner and operator of these two roadways, the Authority itself does not have qualified emergency personnel and apparatus to provide these critical, life-saving services to its patrons therefore, it has been the policy of the Authority to financially assist these first aid squads and fire departments on a semi-annual basis.

Previously approved by the Board, the first aid squads are provided \$90.00 per call plus a \$500.00 semi-annual standby assessment and the fire departments are provided \$160.00 per piece of apparatus plus a \$300.00 semi-annual standby assessment. Organizations providing mutual aid are not provided an assessment for stand-by, but are provided an assessment of \$90.00 per call or \$160.00 per number of apparatus.


Accordingly, it is recommended that the Authority be authorized to work with the first aid squads and fire departments providing services on the New Jersey Turnpike and Garden State Parkway under the terms set forth above in an amount not to exceed \$570,000.00 for the year 2023.







The following un-audited results are for the month ended January 31, 2023.¹ Based upon these results, revenues will be sufficient to satisfy the requirements of the Authority's Bond Resolution. For the twelve months ending December 31, 2023, the Authority is projected to have a debt service coverage ratio of 1.84 and a total requirements coverage ratio of 1.42.

The Authority's total revenue for the month ended January 31, 2023 was \$198,847,000, which is \$17,147,000, or 9.4%, above the 2023 year-to-date budget. Toll revenue was \$166,724,000, which is \$8,924,000, or 5.7%, more than the 2023 year-to-date budget. Toll revenue is greater than budget primarily due to milder than expected winter weather. Gas prices averaged \$0.05/gallon higher in 2023 compared to the same period in 2022. However, when compared to December 2022, gas prices have remained relatively the same in January 2023. Investment income was \$3,447,000, or 101.4%, above budget due to both an increase in interest rates above the rates that were budgeted and higher invested balances. E-ZPass fees were \$3,527,000, or 35.3%, above the budget due to conservative budgeting in 2023.

For the month ended January 31, 2023, traffic on the New Jersey Turnpike increased 16.9% and toll revenue increased 16.0% compared to the same period in 2022. The increase in traffic is primarily due to mild winter weather, as passenger car traffic increased over 19% compared to January 2022. Toll revenue increased primarily due to the increase in traffic as well as the 3% annual toll rate indexing which went into effect on January 1, 2023. In addition, traffic and revenue also increased due to more travel during the January 2023 New Year's Day and Martin Luther King Day holidays compared to the same periods as last year. Also, the month of January 2023 had one extra weekday compared to January 2022, which positively impacted results. The 2023 traffic and toll revenue budgets are based on the Authority's traffic engineering consultant's (CDM Smith) Draw Down Letter dated July 22, 2022 updating the September 21, 2018 Toll Revenue Forecast. CDM Smith projected a 12.1% increase in traffic and a 9.5% increase in revenue as compared to the prior year. The actual results for the month ended January 31, 2023 were above CDM's projections. When compared to the same period in 2019, pre-pandemic, traffic is down 2.9% but revenue is up 40.4% for the same period. Traffic has recovered to about 97.0% of pre-pandemic levels. Through January 2023, the E-ZPass usage rate on the New Jersey Turnpike was 92.4%, an increase from 91.3% for the same period in 2022.

For the month ended January 31, 2023, toll transactions on the Garden State Parkway increased 18.6% and revenue increased 22.3% when compared to the same period in 2022. The increase in toll transactions is primarily due to less severe winter weather, while toll revenue increased mainly due to the increase in toll transactions as well as the 3% annual toll rate indexing. Increased travel during the New Year's Day and Martin Luther King Day holiday weekends as compared to last year also positively impacted results. Also, the month of January 2023 had one extra weekday compared to January 2022 resulting in higher transactions and revenue, as weekdays tend to have more overall traffic than weekend days. The actual results for the month ended January 31, 2023 were above the budget which was based on CDM Smith's projection of a 13.1% increase in toll transactions and a 16.5% increase in toll revenue. When compared to the same period in 2019, pre-pandemic, traffic is down 3.1% and revenue is up 30.4%. Traffic has recovered to about 97.0% of pre-pandemic levels. Through January 2023, the E-ZPass usage rate on the Garden State Parkway was 90.3%, an increase from 89.5% for the same period in 2022.

Operating expenses for the month ended January 31, 2023 were approximately \$46,942,000, which is \$3,564,000, or 7.1% below the year-to-date budget. The Authority's operating expenses through January were below budget primarily due to lower than budgeted snow/severe weather costs, salaries because of existing vacancies, and ETC costs due to lower banking and credit card fees. These factors were partially offset by higher than budgeted insurance and health benefits costs. The Authority spent a total of only \$544,000 for snow and severe weather costs in 2023 from the operating expense budget. All snow and severe weather costs are considered operating expenses and paid from the Revenue Fund, except for declared state of emergency events, which are charged to the General Reserve Fund. New Jersey had no declared state of emergency event in January 2023. The Authority still has about \$70,000,000 in total available in its 2023 operating expense and general reserve budgets for snow and severe weather costs.

**Financial Summary
For the Month Ended January 31, 2023**

Debt Service includes interest and principal payments on the Authority's outstanding bonds. For the month ended January 31, 2023, Debt Service totaled \$76,410,000, which was \$3,423,000 or 4.3% below budget and included \$49,837,000 in interest payments and \$26,573,000 in principal payments. Debt Service is below budget partly because the budget assumed a \$1,000,000,000 new money bond issuance in January 2023 which to date has not been required.

The General Reserve Fund includes all contractual payments subordinate to bondholders and expenditures for any other corporate purpose. The General Reserve Fund spending totaled \$71,577,000 for the month ended January 31, 2023, which was \$5,626,000 or 7.3% below budget. Spending consisted primarily of \$62,167,000 for the new State Transportation Agreement, \$1,833,000 for the Transportation Trust Fund, and \$1,250,000 for Other Post-Employment Benefits. Also included are \$4,452,000 in transfers to the Supplemental Capital program in the Construction Fund. General Reserve is below budget mainly because there was no spending on state of emergency snow/severe weather events.

The Capital Budget, which is funded by revenue, consists of the Maintenance Reserve Fund, Special Project Reserve Fund, and the Supplemental Capital Program. For the month ended January 31, 2023, total expenditures were approximately \$6,054,000, which was 36.7% of the year-to-date spending budget. Expenditures included \$2,586,000 for TPK Resurfacing Milepost 0-122, \$525,000 for GSP Milepost 126-172 Bridge Repairs, and \$512,000 for TPK Milepost 92-122 & NHBCE Bridge Repairs and Resurfacing. In addition to these expenditures, there are open contracts and commitments totaling approximately \$313,282,000.

The Construction Fund, which is funded from bond proceeds, consists of the 2023-2027 Capital Improvement Program, 2019 Capital Improvement Program, and the 2008 \$7 Billion Capital Improvement Program. For the month ended January 31, 2023, total expenditures were approximately \$24,724,000, which was 36.5% of the year-to-date spending budget. Total expenditures included \$4,612,000 for GSP 128 AB 154.2N & TPK 90-91.37, \$3,527,000 for TPK Bridge Rehabilitation W107.87, E107.88 and 84.24N&S, \$2,140,000 for TPK Deck Reconstruction 98.48 to 98.76, and \$1,392,000 for GSP Shoulder Widening Reconstruction MP 30-35. In addition to these expenditures, there are open contracts and commitments totaling approximately \$876,906,000.




RE: Authorization to Engage the Law Firms of Genova Burns LLC and Connell Foley LLP as Special Counsels for the New Jersey Turnpike Authority to the Hudson Tunnel Project and the Tremley Point Project

Authorization is requested to engage the law firms of Genova Burns LLC and Connell Foley LLP to provide, respectively, Special Labor Counsel and representation with regard to the development of a project labor agreement(s) (“PLA”) applicable to the Hudson Tunnel Project and as Special Real Estate Counsel for the Tremley Point Project, (collectively, the “Projects”) each to be paid at a rate different from the rates currently being billed to the Authority as Special Labor Counsel and Special Real Estate Counsel. Attorneys at Genova Burns LLC and Connell Foley LLP providing PLA services for the Projects would be paid each at the blended hourly rate of \$400.00; however, the hourly rate to be paid for services provided by paralegals will remain at the current contractual rate of \$90.00 per hour. The intended team from Genova Burns LLC for the Projects will include name partner Angelo Genova and partners James J. McGovern, Patrick W. McGovern and Douglas Solomon. Assigned associates are Brian D. MacNiven, Christopher Manley, Victor Andreou and Katherine Szabo with discretion to identify additional attorneys if required. The Connell Foley LLP intended team will be W. Nevins McCann, Patrick McCauley, Kevin Coakley and Thomas Cosma, with the discretion to identify additional attorneys if required. Each of the law firms’ decades-long history in negotiating numerous PLAs in connection with some of the region’s most substantial infrastructure and construction projects combined with their special competence in this work justifies an hourly attorney rate different from the current rates billed to the Authority as Special Labor Counsel and Special Real Estate Counsel, as the case may be. With knowledge of this legal expertise and need, the Governor’s Authorities Unit has approved and authorizes the Authority to also approve these rates. Therefore, in accordance with Executive Order No. 37 (Jon S. Corzine, September 26, 2006), the legal requirements to engage these attorney services through a publicly advertised competitive process do not apply under the express exception for authorization by the Governor’s Authorities Unit.


Accordingly, approval to engage each of the law firms of Genova Burns LLC and Connell Foley LLP under the terms set forth herein is respectfully requested.
