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


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NEW JERSEY POPULATION TRENDS BY COUNTIES

During the 1950-1960 decade the state's population was increased by almost $1\frac{1}{4}$ million persons, bringing the overall total to over 6 million people. This increase was widely distributed over the state, but some areas, of course, grew by leaps and bounds, while others increased very slightly, and in some more or less isolated cases, actually declined in population from 1950 to 1960.

In order to make the facts of population available in such form as to be most useful to the largest number of people, this report is essentially a presentation of some of the general characteristics of this 6 million people in New Jersey, based on the facts and figures found in the 1960 U. S. Census of Population.

Many people view population merely as a statistic published every ten years by the U. S. Bureau of Census. However, to others the changes in the character and form of the population which these figures reveal, signal the development or decline of an area. Through careful study those figures can provide significant information to planners, industrial and housing developers, government and education officials, and many others concerned with programming, looking ahead to future needs, or analysing trends and characteristics of the people. Population is a dynamic force in a constant state of flux; it is a force which both determines and is attracted by the future of a state.

In reviewing the population trends which have occurred during the history of the state, three factors appear to be basic: time, climate, and location. New Jersey is a state which can boast of being situated between two great cities, New York and Philadelphia, it offers essentially a four-season climate, and a history which goes back to the beginning of the nation - a combination which must in the long run attract a sizeable portion of population.

New Jersey, with its 7,500 square miles of land area is one of the smallest of the 50 states. However, its population density is the second highest in the nation for the second consecutive decade. It is within five persons per square mile of having the most persons per square mile, on an average. In 1960 New Jersey's average density was 807 persons per square mile, compared to the U. S. average of about 50 per square mile for the same period, and the next below New Jersey is the state of Massachusetts with 654 persons per square mile.

The number of persons per square mile in the top ten states in terms of density is as follows:

It is no wonder that New Jersey is rated as the most urban state in the nation -- 88.6% compared with 85.4% in New York State, 78.3% in Connecticut, 71.6% in Pennsylvania, and a national average of 69.9% urbanity.

Population Change

Three factors are prominent in population growth or decline, namely births, deaths and migration. As a general rule the importance of migration to the overall population change increases as the size of the area studied decreases. Certainly it is easy to realize that migration has no affect on world population, but as we go down the scale in political units -- country, state, county, municipality, the relative importance of migration becomes magnified.

While there has been a significant range in both birth and death rates among the 50 states of our country, there appears to be little, if any, correlation between these factors and the rate of decline or rise in population. In fact, if one compares the birth and death rates for the 5 states with the greatest population gain since 1950 with similar data for the 5 states with the least population gain during the same period, it would be apparent that not only did the bottom group have a higher birth rate but also a lower death rate. Unfortunately, however, there is not a distinct inverse correlation when every state is considered. The only conclusion which can then be drawn is that the rate of population growth among states is due in varying degrees to migration.

A useful reference tool will be found on the following pages, where all cities, towns, townships, boroughs and villages are listed in alphabetical order, with their 1960 and 1950 populations, per cent change, and densities per square mile shown. A later tabulation is given on pages 22 to 33 ranking all municipalities in order of size, showing the densities, area in square miles and rank in density for each.

Density

A study of the density pattern of New Jersey reveals some very interesting facts. Although the average density in the state as a whole is 807.9 persons per square mile, there are 29 municipalities of over 10,000 density, the highest of these is West New York with 39,497 persons per square mile, which is more than the 34,525 average density of the Borough of Brooklyn, or the 32,830 of the Bronx, New York.

Another 77 municipalities have densities of between 5,000 and 10,000; 309 have densities over 1,000, and 336 of the 568 municipalities have densities above the average for the state. As would be expected, the municipalities with a small number of square miles are the most densely populated, with the exception of Newark and Jersey City, and those with large areas have few persons per square mile. There are only 36 municipalities in New Jersey which are less dense than the average for the United States.

New Jersey's density, moreover, is confined to a corridor-belt extending from metropolitan New York to metropolitan Philadelphia.



Migration

In considering population changes among the counties within a single state and especially a state the size of New Jersey, the significance of migration is great. In the analysis of New Jersey counties it will be seen how dynamic these changes can be.

But what are the underlying factors which cause huge segments of a population to move from one area to another. Is it the attractiveness of the new area or is it the obsolescence of the old? What makes a particular area attractive? There is no clear cut answer, since each individual or family will make its own evaluation based on its preferences and needs. In general, however, climate, employment opportunities, family economics, leisure time attractions, and living conditions are probably the most influencing factors for any migration. A network of fine highways and the resulting mobility of a skilled labor force also play their part in New Jersey.

The importance of good employment opportunities in an area should be quite obvious. But this is not a one-way street. While people will always move on to so-called greener pastures, it is not uncommon for industry to relocate, based very often on the availability of labor. Or if it relocates for any number of other reasons, often the company will take large segments of its work force with it. Essentially what this does is add greatly to the rate of population and migration.

In the state, 48.0 per cent of the net increase in population between 1950 and 1960 was attributable to migration. Most counties had a net immigration, with a percentage of increase of from 21.5 to 83.8. There were two counties, however, where the net natural increment of births over deaths was greater than the net change in population over the decade, resulting in a net loss due to migration.

Institutional Population in Group Quarters.

According to Bureau of the Census definitions, all persons who are not members of households (one person can constitute a household) are regarded as living in group quarters. Group quarters are living arrangements for institutional inmates, or for groups of five or more unrelated persons. Included in these categories are military and other types of barracks, college dormitories, fraternity or sorority houses, hospitals, homes for nurses, convents, monasteries, residences for clergy, ships and vessels, and lodging and boarding houses where the persons are unrelated to the person in charge, whose quarters are not divided into housing units. A house or an apartment shared by six or more unrelated persons or in which five or more lodgers share with a family or an individual such quarters as the living room or dining room, is also classified as group quarters.

Inmates of institutions are those for whom care or custody is being provided; in such places as homes for delinquent or dependent children, homes for the mentally affected or physically handicapped, places providing specialized medical care for persons with mental disorders, tuberculosis or other chronic diseases, nursing or domiciliary homes for the aged and dependent persons, and jails. Resident institutional staff members who do not live in separate housing units and all persons in group quarters other than those in institutions, are included in the category "other".

Certain municipalities and counties often have a high proportion of their total population in institutions, colleges, military posts and such. Therefore, in considering social and economic characteristics of the residents in these areas, it is often more desirable to exclude these populations. For this reason, we have listed the amount of such population which are found in counties and in selected areas.

Age, Sex and Race

In order to make the greatest use of the vast quantities of statistical information made available by the decennial census, age breakdowns for various groups will be given for all municipalities in another Research Report on the population. However, a summarization of the age group distributions for the state since 1890, and the county age groups and marital status as of 1960, are shown on the accompanying pages.

The breakdowns of male and female are comprehensive in the 1960 Census, but except in special cases, a mere differentiation of the number of men and women in a given municipality is quite adequate for analysis, so we have limited the presentation of this material. However, more complete information can be obtained upon request.

The following schedules show a breakdown of races between white and non-white for all counties and all municipalities, together with a percentage of non-white. Non-white consists of such races as the Negro, Indian, Japanese, Chinese, Philippino, Korean, Asian Indian and Malayan. Persons of Mexican parentage or ancestry who are not definitely of Indian race, as well as Puerto Ricans, are classified as white. Persons of mixed national parentage are classified according to the race of the non-white parent, and mixtures of non-white races are generally classified according to the race of the father. It has been noted that in New Jersey there are very few of the other non-white races apart from the Negro.

In almost every county there has been an increase in the percentage of non-whites over the past ten years; the largest county increases were in Essex, from 11.6% to 19.8%; Mercer, 9.0% to 12.9%; Hudson, 3.7% to 6.9%; and Passaic, 3.6% to 6.7%. In Burlington, there was a decrease from 8.1% in 1950 to 6.9% in 1960.

Households

A household includes all of the persons who occupy a house, apartment or other group of rooms, or a room which constitutes a "housing unit". A single room or a group of rooms is regarded as a housing unit when it is occupied as separate living quarters: that is, when the actual or intended occupants do not live and eat with any other persons in the structure, and when there is either (1) direct access from the outside or through a common hall, or (2) a kitchen or cooking equipment for the exclusive use of the occupants.

Full information was not available for all municipalities on the number of households and the number of persons in households in the 1950 Census, so that there are gaps in the percentage increases shown on the accompanying pages from 1950 - 1960. Wherever information is available, it has been recorded, however.

As a county, Cape May has the lowest average number of persons per household: 2.85, and for the highest persons per household, Burlington and Middlesex are tied, both with 3.53. The individual municipalities vary from 2.46 in Mantoloking and 2.52 in Pahaquarry to 3.98 in Levittown and Hi-Nella. Extremes at either end of the scale are shown by the Census in the special cases of Teterboro (Bergen Co.), with a total population of 22 and 10 households, making 2.20 persons per household, and New Hanover (Burlington Co.) with its 25,036 as part of Fort Dix, having only 822 households with an average of 4.25 per household outside of the Army barracks.

The average number of persons per household for the state as a whole was 3.27 in 1960. This compares with the 3.39 reported in 1950. This decrease does not necessarily indicate a decrease in the number of children per family; rather, it may indicate new family formations are taking place at a temporarily faster rate, or that the number of older people not living in household or family units, has been increasing.
