## State Library Updates

### Applications Now Open & Guidelines Available for REV 250 Grant

We are now accepting applications for our **REV 250: Examining the Semiquincentennial through a Jersey Lens** grant opportunity. This grant will allow public libraries to design projects that highlight the people, places, and events that shaped our state, with awards ranging from \$2,500 to \$25,000. Grant options will include:

- **Digitization Projects** to safeguard and provide access to local historic materials.
- **Public Programming** to celebrate and educate through events and community engagement.
- **Special Collections** to build or enhance library collections related to New Jersey's rich history.
