**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES**  
**JUNE 1995**

Comparing counts for June 30, 1995 with those on June 30, 1994, the following changes are noted:

**RESIDENTS**

- 4% increase from 24,595 to 25,699 for all institutions;
- 4% increase from 23,956 to 25,060 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 14% increase from 3,440 to 3,908 for county waiting;
- 9% increase from 917 to 1002 for county contract and county assistance;
- 2% increase from 14,666 to 14,936 for the prison complex;
- 6% increase from 4,933 to 5,214 for the youth facilities; and
- 0% No change from 639 to 639 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

**ADMISSIONS**

- 18% increase from 1,351 to 1,590 for total admissions;
- 20% increase from 1,232 to 1,473 for adults; and
- -2% decrease from 119 to 117 for juveniles.

**RELEASES**

- 7% increase from 1,127 to 1,201 for total releases;
- 3% increase from 794 to 819 for adult male parole releases;
- 48% increase from 62 to 92 for adult female parole releases;
- 6% increase from 856 to 911 for total adult parole releases;
- -6% decrease from 231 to 217 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 83% increase from 40 to 73 for juvenile releases.

**NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I - community, SL II - minimum, SL III - medium, SL IV - maximum and SL V - close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
