#### [Exploit Kits: A Prevailing Vector for Malware Distribution](#)

Since first appearing around 2006, exploit kits (EK) have evolved into one of the most prevalent web-based vectors for malware distribution and a threat facing nearly all internet users. An EK is a malicious toolkit designed to distribute different malware variants by exploiting common vulnerabilities found in outdated or unpatched software applications, such as web browsers and plugins.

### Tip of the Week

*"Think before you app"*

Only download apps from reputable sources, like verified app stores. Understand that information (i.e., location, social networking profiles, etc.) the app would access and share before you download.
