**Trenton, NJ** – Governor Chris Christie was in Totowa today to view the progress of the \$5 million Interstate 80 bridge repair project in Passaic County, funded by the state's Transportation Trust Fund (TTF). He met with the workers on the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) project that is rehabilitating the bridge, which spans the Passaic River from Totowa Borough to Woodland Park. Work includes fatigue crack and long-term retrofit repairs at each of the bridge's intermediate cross-frame connections to its steel girders. This will transfer and reduce the load on the bridge and will maintain and prevent future fatigue and stress to the structure while increasing safety for the 130,000 vehicles that cross the 767-foot long bridge every day.
