New Jersey is a state on the move--in proportion to its size, it has more miles of railway--more miles of superhighway--than any other state. Everyday, 96 percent of the State's work force, or over 2 million workers, employ a variety of means to get to their jobs. More than half (61 percent) of New Jersey's workers travel by automobile, about 15 percent go by bus or streetcar, 10 percent walk to work, 4 percent travel by railway or subway, and 4 percent work at home.

The distance and means of transportation to work is an important factor in the analysis of a community. To give an indication of the commuting population of New Jersey, the Research and Statistics Section has prepared this compilation of 1960 Census data. By presenting the means of transportation to work and the place of work in relation to the place of residence, some measure of the volume of commuters from one area to another, and of future transportation needs can be estimated.

Essex County has the largest population of the twenty-one counties. Correspondingly, it has the greatest number of workers living within its boundaries. In Essex County, 71 percent of the workers who live there also work inside the county.

Bergen County has the second greatest number of workers, but has the greatest number who work outside the county, 138,408, amounting to 45.5 percent of the total workers in the county.

Cumberland County reports 89 percent of its workers find employment in the county and only 7.6 percent work outside the county, with the remainder not reported.

Bergen County has the most auto commuters in the state, 193,137, or 64 percent of the county's workers.

Hudson County has the greatest number of rail commuters, 8 percent of the county's workers.

Essex County has the greatest number of bus commuters, 96,252, or 26 percent of its total workers.

Where do these people go everyday on their journey to work? To answer this question in part, a breakdown of the numbers of these people and how many travel where is shown by county and for certain municipalities. The figures presented for municipalities will not always add up to the county total due to the omission of municipalities where insufficient response discouraged release, but were included in the county total.

The figures reported in the 1960 Census are far from complete. In fact, there are serious gaps in the information. They are not reported for all counties and municipalities. They are based on a 25 percent sample, and are based predominately on SMSA material, which, for instance, gives incomplete information for Middlesex County and an important commuting area around New Brunswick.

However, the information yielded is sufficiently important in studying transportation problems that it is deemed worthy of presentation.

If one would revert back a hundred years in time, it would be found that with very few exceptions, if someone worked in one town he also lived there. In the towns with a railroad, there might be some people who commuted for short distances. A century ago, population followed the railroads as it follows today's superhighways.

Based on the 1960 Census findings, the family incomes, by income groups, show the number of families at various levels of income; the median incomes in each area; and median earnings of certain broad occupational groups--male professional, craftsmen, foremen, operatives, laborers, and female clerical and operatives. All information is tabulated by counties, and wherever reported by the Census, by municipalities. 50¢

#### No. 138 - EMPLOYMENT CHARACTERISTICS, LABOR FORCE, AND OCCUPATIONS

The employment status of the population of the state who are 14 years of age and over, as reported in the 1960 Census, are detailed in this report. The numbers in the labor force, male and female, those in the civilian labor force, those not in the labor force, as well as the percentages of employed and unemployed are also given. All series are shown for all counties and for most municipalities of the state, wherever reported. The occupational breakdowns of the population are shown in such categories as professional and technical workers, sales personnel, managers, farm workers, skilled craftsmen and service workers. 50¢

#### No. 139 - ESTIMATES OF POPULATION - 1964

Estimates of population as of July 1, 1964 for all municipalities and counties of the State. Comparisons are shown with the 1960 Census of Population, together with percentages of growth between 1960 and 1964. 50¢

#### No. 140 - CENSUS OF HOUSING - 1960

The total number of dwelling units for all counties and municipalities are detailed with breakdowns of occupied and vacant, vacant for sale or rent, or vacant seasonal. Further breakdowns show the owner occupied and renter occupied units, the condition of the units: sound, deteriorating or dilapidated, number of rooms, size of structure, and similar data. 50¢

#### No. 141 - NEW DWELLING UNITS - 1960-1964

The new dwelling unit permits issued each year are applied to the total number of dwelling units as reported in the Census year of 1960, thus bringing up-to-date the estimates of total dwelling units in each municipality and county of the state. The number of units demolished is also shown, 1960-1964. 50¢

#### No. 142 - TRANSPORTATION AND JOURNEY TO WORK

To aid in the determination of the importance of commuting and transportation of employed persons, tabulations are shown of all those working in county of residence and all those working outside the county of residence. The means of transportation whether by private auto, railway or bus are shown, together with those who walk to work or work at home. This information is available for all counties and for most municipalities. Also shows the number of persons working in selected areas by place of residence, and those living in selected areas by place of work. 50¢

#### No. 143 - DIGEST OF EMPLOYMENT - 1964

This review of employment shows for each of the counties the number of employer units and employees in covered employment within the major industry breakdowns. Listed also are the principal manufacturing industries of each county, as well as population, land area, and density and related percentages. Historical data, showing covered employment for selected years from 1950 for each county, by major industrial categories is included. 50¢

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
