Red Cross recognized by ESGR with "Seven Seals Award"

The American Red Cross South Jersey Service to the Armed Forces was honored at a ceremony April 22, at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst by Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR).

Part of the internationally recognized humanitarian movement that has approximately 97 million members and volunteers, the local chapter was presented a "Seven Seals Award" by the Department of Defense operational organization in recognition for their service and dedication to the men and women who "wear the uniform."

The award, depicting the heraldry of the seven branches of service they represent, is given at the discretion of the ESGR State Chairman to honor those employers that are exemplary in their support of the American military, 48 percent which come from the "citizen soldiers" of the National Guard and Reserve.

American Red Cross Regional director Tim Settles Clementoni, presented the award to American Red Cross Regional director, Tim Settles. In attendance to represent the military was Col. Matthew Lissner, Legislative Liason for the Army Reserve 99th Regional Support Command and Capt. Arnold Adams from the JB MDL's Military Entrance Processing Center.

The Red Cross is tasked with providing a critical service to South Jersey servicemen who are serving overseas. Their emergency communications center quickly and efficiently obtains the required information and sends emergency communications messages to service members of every branch of service, around the globe. Former Marine and Army Reservist, Chris DeMeo, attended the ceremony and personally thanked the Red Cross team members for delivering a message to him about a family emergency when he was deployed. DeMeo is also an ESGR volunteer member.

The American Red Cross Service to the Armed Forces (SAF) also links military families to local resources and support services, provides resiliency training and supports wounded warriors and military hospitals.

Settles, who accepted the award on behalf of the South Jersey Region remarked, "We consider it an honor to partner with the New Jersey Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve and we are humbled to be a recipient of the Seven Seals Award."

ESGR is a Department of Defense, mostly volunteer organization that seeks to create a culture where all American employers value the military service and sacrifice of their employees. They accomplish this by advocating relevant initiatives, recognizing outstanding support, increasing awareness of applicable laws and resolving conflict between employers and service members.

Beneficiaries must sign up for TRICARE automatic payment by May 31

Beneficiaries enrolled in TRICARE Reserve Select or TRI-CARE Retired Reserve who pay monthly premiums by check must switch to an electronic form of payment by May 31 to avoid losing coverage.

TRICARE will only accept monthly premium payments using recurring automatic payments by credit or debit card, or by recurring electronic funds transfer from a linked bank account. To avoid confusion, beneficiaries should verify that their bank sends EFT payments electronically.

The Defense Manpower Data Center notified current TRR and TRS beneficiaries directly by email, and new beneficiaries were informed in their welcome package information when enrolling.

Electronic payments streamline account management and ensure continuous coverage for beneficiaries. Failure to pay premiums by the due date results in termination of coverage.

Beneficiaries can contact their regional contractor to set up automatic payments and get more information.

"There are still a considerable number of Air Force reservists in the west region who have yet to establish their automated payment option with TRICARE for their monthly TRS/TRR premi-



ums," said James F. Walsh, the Air Force Reserve chief of Benefits and Entitlements Policy. "Those members who do not have this requirement established by the deadline will have their coverage suspended and possibly terminated for 12 months come June 1."


Soldiers/Airmen and Family members are cordially invited to attend "Military Appreciation Day" at the New Jersey Shore.


