Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I - community, SL II - minimum, SL III - medium, SL IV - maximum, SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence.
