Bills With Recent Legislative Action:

- **S1253** - (Sen Greenstrin, Sen Moriarty, Sen Johnson, Sen Mukherji) **(Identical Bill A3549)** (Asm Greenwald, Asw Murphy, Asw Quijano, Asw Lopez, Asm Sampson) Concerns eligibility for unemployment benefits.
- **A4375** - (Asm Calabrese, Asw Carter) **(Identical Bill S3740)** (Sen Diegnan) Specifies electric vehicle parking space calculation is rounded up if it includes fraction of a whole number and rounded-up parking spaces cannot reduce overall parking supply by more than 10 percent.
