FROM: Office of Policy Analysis and Planning
DATE: September 14, 1993

As of July 1, 1993 Juvenile Residential and Day Programs were transferred to the Division of Juvenile Services, Department of Human Services. The New Jersey Training School for Boys and the Juvenile Medium Security Facility remain under DOC administration.

We will continue to report counts for the Juvenile Residential and Day Programs in the Admissions Releases and Residents Report (Page 5) as long as these data continue to be provided to us by the Department of Human Services.

ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS
SEPTEMBER 1993

Compared to the trimester ending September 30, 1992 Admissions for trimester ending September 30, 1993 were:

- Up 2% from 2672 to 2738 for the Prison;
- Up 18% from 206 to 243 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility;
- Down 26% from 145 to 107 for the Youth Complex; and
- Up 18% from 250 to 295 for Juvenile Facilities.

Resident counts on September 30, 1993 compared to the end of September 30, 1992 were:

- Up 3% from 22,323 to 23,047 for the Adult-Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Up 8% from 3033 to 3287 for County Waiting;
- Up 2% from 23,282 to 23,646 for all Institutions;
- Up from 13,954 to 14,013 for the Prison;
- Up from 4806 to 4829 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Down 1% from 586 to 583 for Juvenile Facilities.

NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ **PAROLE RELEASES** are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ **MEDIUM/MAX UNITS:** Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
