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**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
DECEMBER 1995**

Comparing counts for December 31, 1995 with those on December 31, 1994, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 10% increase from 24,791 to 27,331 for all institutions;
- 9% increase from 24,187 to 26,574 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 27% increase from 3,344 to 4,258 for county waiting;
- 14% increase from 915 to 1040 for county contract and county assistance;
- 6% increase from 14,857 to 15,701 for the prison complex;
- 10% increase from 5,071 to 5,575 for the youth facilities; and
- 25% increase from 604 to 757 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- -2% decrease from 1,117 to 1,099 for total admissions;
- 0% (no chg) from 1,010 to 1,010 for adults; and
- -17% decrease from 107 to 89 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 19% increase from 950 to 1,131 for total releases;
- 17% increase from 596 to 696 for adult male parole releases;
- 54% increase from 59 to 91 for adult female parole releases;
- 20% increase from 655 to 787 for total adult parole releases;
- 23% increase from 209 to 258 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 0% (no chg) from 86 to 86 for juvenile releases.

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NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
