OFFICE OF THE STATE LIBRARIAN,
TRENTON, N. J., November 1, 1876. }

To his Excellency, Joseph D. Bedle, Governor of New Jersey :

I have the honor to submit the following report of the State Library for the year ending October 31st, 1876.

An appropriation of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500) was made by the last Legislature for the improvement of the library room, the work has been done under the supervision of the Secretary of State and State Treasurer, and finished within the appropriation, the bills having been paid through the Comptroller's office; the books of that office will show how the money has been expended. The new part of the room has been finished to correspond with the old, the wood work repainted, the walls frescoed, and the room newly furnished throughout; the room will now correspond with other parts of the building, and I think will compare favorably with the State Library rooms of other States.

Valuable additions have been made to the Law Library during the year, two hundred and ninety-two (292) volumes having been added by purchase, while only eighteen (18) volumes have been purchased for the Miscellaneous Library, and only twelve (12) volumes have been received from donation. The State Libraries generally receive by donation many of the newspapers published in their respective States, while we receive but one. One newspaper from each county in the State would be a valuable acquisition to the Library, and I would suggest to the publishers throughout the State that their papers on file here would be welcomed by many readers, and would very often furnish valuable information to legislators and members of the bar that could not be obtained from other sources.

The last report represented the total number of books belonging to the Library as twenty thousand five hundred and thirty-nine

(20,539), during the past year seven hundred and fifty-two (752) volumes have been added from the following sources:
