SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 TO RULING NO. 3

REVISIONS IN ALLOWANCES FOR OLD AGE ASSISTANCE AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE


The revised schedules for Food, Therapeutic Diets, Personal and Household Needs issued by the Division of Welfare for the Categorical Assistance Budget Manual, authorized to be effective January 1, 1959, are hereby incorporated in Ruling No. 3.

These revised allowances shall be applied to all Old Age and Disability Assistance cases in the following manner:

1. New, reopened and reinstated cases being processed for January business and thereafter shall be budgeted in conformity with the new allowances.
2. All currently active cases shall be reexamined and rebudgeted in conformity with the new standards during the month of January, in such manner that every client entitled to a budget adjustment by reason of these new standards shall have such adjustment reflected in the payment issued at the end of January 1959.

It may be noted that the increased allowances authorized by these revisions do not affect clients budgeted on an institutional living basis, nor those budgeted on a boarding basis. It should further be noted that the timing of these changes is intended to be simultaneous with rebudgeting for many of these clients that will be necessary during January by reason of increases in income from OASDI.

REVISIONS IN ALLOWANCES FOR OLD AGE AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE

The revised schedules for Food, Personal Data, Personal and Household Needs, issued by the Division of Welfare for the Categories Assistance Budget Manual, authorized to be effective January 1, 1957, are hereby incorporated in Bulletin No. 3.

These revised allowances shall be applied to all Old Age and Disability Assistance cases in the following manner:

1. New, opened and reopened cases being processed for January business shall be adjusted to conform with the new allowances.

2. All currently active cases shall be reexamined and reclassified in accordance with the new standards during the month of January, in which month they are entitled to a budget adjustment by reason of these new standards. All have such adjustment reflected in the payment issued at the end of January 1957.

It is noted that the increased allowances authorized by these revisions do not affect clients' payment on an institutional living basis; nor those on a boarding basis. It should further be noted that the timing of these changes is intended to be simultaneous with revisions for many of these cases that will be necessary during January by reason of increases in income from Social Security.
