Gov. Christie Whitman today submitted to the State Senate her notice of intention to nominate Charles Middlesworth, Jr. of Ventnor to be a judge of the Superior Court.

Middlesworth is managing partner in the law firm of Shultz and Middlesworth in Linwood, a general civil practice. Previously, he was a partner in the law firm of Middlesworth, Beakley & Barry.

He has served as staff attorney and executive director of the non-profit Cape Atlantic Legal Services Inc. He currently is a trustee with that organization.

Middlesworth earned his law degree from Indiana University School of Law and holds an economics degree from Indiana University. He was admitted to the New Jersey bar in 1971.

He presently serves on the Ventnor Board of Education, the Ventnor Recreation Advisory Board, Ventnor Little League, and the National Association of Youth Sports Coaches, and is counsel to the Pop Lloyd Committee.

Also today, Gov. Whitman submitted her intention to renominate Judge Jack Kirsten of Short Hills as a Superior Court judge.
