EXPLANATION OF COLUMN HEADINGS

Column

- 1 EQUALIZED VALUATION PER PUPIL - The equalized valuation of property in the school district as of October 1, 1973 divided by the resident enrollment as of September 28, 1973.
- 2 CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET PER PUPIL - Total 1974-75 current expense budget (less tuition received) divided by the resident enrollment on September 28, 1973. Budget data represent budgets as advertised in January 1974.
- 3 PRESENT STATE SUPPORT DOLLARS, 1974-75 - The sum of (1) equalization aid (if any) with \$38,000 guaranteed valuation per weighted pupil; (2) minimum support of \$132 per weighted pupil; (3) transportation aid - 75% of approved costs; (4) atypical pupil aid - 50% of expenditures; (5) building aid - \$45 foundation program per weighted pupil less local fair share of 3/4 mill; (6) save harmless - equalization and building aids are not less than the amount of prior year.
- 4 PROPOSED STATE SUPPORT DOLLARS
 - A. Current expense state support includes:
 - (1) equalization aid with \$106,000 guaranteed valuation per unweighted pupil and state support up to the 65th percentile level of per pupil expenditures (currently \$1,500).
 - (2) 100% state support of excess costs of programs to meet special needs -- (a) special education, (b) bi-lingual, (c) state compensatory, and (d) approved local area vocational education.
 - B. Debt service state support equals the same percentage of the budgeted principal and interest as applies to current expense equalization aid.

Note - County vocational schools are included in the program. The county average equalized valuation per pupil determines the state-local sharing of expenditures.
- 5 INCREASE - The amount of the proposed support (column 4) less the amount currently paid (column 3). Decreases are shown in parentheses.
- 6 PRESENT STATE SUPPORT PERCENT - State support dollars in column 3 divided by the adjusted total budget for current expenses, debt service and budgeted capital outlay.
- 7 PROPOSED STATE SUPPORT PERCENT - State support dollars in column 4 divided by the adjusted total budget for current expenses, debt service and budgeted capital outlay.
- 8 PRESENT EFFECTIVE TAX RATE - The rates have been computed by dividing the total local school levy for current expenses, debt service and budgeted capital outlay by the equalized valuation of property as certified on October 1, 1973. Rates have been corrected for appeals. In two out of every three districts approximately half of the levy would be raised in 1974 and the remainder collected as part of 1975 taxes. In these districts the impact of local tax reductions would be spread over two calendar years.
- 9 PROPOSED EFFECTIVE TAX RATE - The proposed levy is the total adjusted budget for all accounts less the total state support. The computation is similar to the description in column 8.
