#### Ransomware: Lucrative Cyber Crime Tactics Rapidly Evolving

The NJCCIC assesses ransomware infections will continue to increase steadily and pose a threat to the public and private sector, as well as home users, as the technical barriers to conduct these cybercrime campaigns continue to drop and the return on investment for cybercriminals remains extremely high.

Ransomware variants are likely to increasingly target mobile devices as users rely more heavily on tablets and smartphones, and also bundle with additional malware designed to steal login credentials and financial information.
