The region's total air passenger volume landed in negative territory in the month of November (-3 percent/-331,785 passengers) as all four airports recorded declines. [Note that Thanksgiving fell on November 28, which pushed some of that holiday's travel into early December.] The domestic sector led the fall (-233,164 travelers/-3.2 percent). Carriers cut domestic seats by 1.2 percent. International passenger activity fell by 2.6 percent (-98,621 travelers), while international seats decreased by 1.9 percent. The region's total cargo volume posted its sixth straight drop of 2019 (-7.3 percent/-14,657 tons). The domestic cargo segment was the major contributor to the decline as it recorded its first double-digit fall of 2019 (-11.3 percent/-8,565 tons). International freight volume (accounting for over 60 percent of our region's total cargo activity) entered its second year of negative performance (-6,092 tons/-4.9 percent).
