Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Strong passenger growth again at +12.6% for the region. The 4.2% freight growth includes corrected data for Continental. Passenger growth will likely taper off some in months ahead, as airlines lick their wounds from this year's competitive low fare battles coupled with stiff fuel price increases.
