REPORT

*To His Excellency, Edward I. Edwards, Governor, and the Honorable
Members of the Senate and General Assembly:*

We, the undersigned, members of the Board of Shell Fisheries, beg leave to submit to your Excellency and Honorable Body, the following Report:

This report is made in accordance with the law creating this Department and covers the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1921, and contains the receipts of the Department together with the names and addresses of all lessees and the number of acres of oyster grounds held by each and the names and addresses of all licenses as of record in the offices of the Departments and Divisions and in the office of the Board of Shell Fisheries in Trenton. Also, the approximate amount of business done during the year, the condition of the industry at the close of the year and the recommendations for the preservation and improvement of the same.

The year 1921 has been one of the best years in the history of the industry for the Southern part of the State, which embraces the Delaware Bay and Maurice River Cove. On the Seaboard conditions have not been so favorable. The scarcity, and consequent high price of seed oysters prevented the planting of much of the leased ground and caused many planters to cancel their leases, as a result of which shipments were much lighter than formerly.

The planting season, May 1st to June 30th, in the Delaware Bay and Maurice River Cove, was one of the most satisfactory the oystermen have ever had and the prospects on the Seaboard look much brighter as the grounds leased in Barnegat Bay for the propagation of seed oysters have a wonderful growth on them and unless something out of the ordinary happens, there should be a fairly good supply of seed oysters for the planting of Seaboard waters in the spring of 1922. This brings us to the close of the fiscal year 1921 with the prospect of a good seed supply for 1922, with one of the greatest crops of marketable oysters ever produced in Delaware Bay and, according to Dr. Nelson, a bright prospect of their being fat September 1st. On the Seaboard, however, the exact reverse confronts us. Here we have a limited quantity of very high priced stock planted and, according to the pre-

dictions of Dr. Nelson, these oysters will be poor when the season opens September 1st. His conclusions are based on the amount of oyster food found in the waters of the different localities and we find him very reliable.

In our general statement of last year we called your attention to the fact that the scarcity of seed oysters was in a measure largely responsible for the falling off in our receipts, the effect being that the lessees, failing to get seed to plant, cancelled their leases for oyster grounds. We are sure that the fine catch of seed oysters in Barnegat Bay will stimulate leasing for planting as well as for more extensive propagation of seed oysters another year.

We also called your attention to the fact that trade waste had been a contributing factor to the falling off in our receipts. We now further advise that leases for about two thousand acres of propagating and planting ground were cancelled in Raritan River, Raritan Bay, Staten Island Sound and Newark Bay during the fiscal year because of the condition created by the trade waste which, if it does not kill the oysters, so discolors and affects them as to make them unfit for food. We would also call your attention to the fact that Dr. Nelson, our Biologist, is keeping in close touch with the Federal authorities and various national and state associations who are investigating and experimenting with the idea of either neutralizing these deleterious effluents or preventing the discharge of them into our streams and other inland and coastal waters.

We would now call your attention to what we understand will be an organized effort by the Clammers for legislation to undo the work which has been done by the Board of Shell Fisheries. As we know only too well the sympathy that their false pleas create, we would issue this word of warning or advice and call attention to the fact that no matter how diligently and honestly officials perform their duties, there are always those who are ready to misrepresent and those who are eager to hear and believe them. Now the fact of the matter is that this class of people live off of that which nature produces and notwithstanding the fact that we as a Board and as individuals have made every possible effort to induce them to forsake their destructive methods and adopt the ways and customs of their more prosperous neighbors, they do not seem to care to do so. If the Legislature listens to the pleas of these people, they are playing into the hands of those who have destroyed our natural oyster beds and have so depleted our natural clam grounds that only one hundred can be caught where from three hundred to as high as one thousand could be caught before. They will tell you that they can make as much money now as they did then. That is true because they get for one hundred more than they used to get for one thousand but is

this continuous advance in price fair to the public when it is caused by a wanton depletion or destruction of a most valuable natural product that can and should be conserved and developed and would be if business methods were adopted instead of letting sentiment and politics rule?

The estimated value of shellfish products of the State for the fiscal year just closed, F. O. B., at the various shipping points, is \$10,125,000.00.

REPORT OF BIOLOGIST

INTRODUCTION

The investigations of the Biologist since his appointment to the Board, July 1st, 1920, may be grouped under the following headings:

1. Studies of the rate and extent of growth of adult oysters (begun in 1919).
2. Studies of yearly and seasonal variations in the food of the oyster (begun in 1916).
3. The influence of temperature, density, turbidity and other factors on the rate and extent of feeding of oysters.
4. Further investigations of the distribution and behavior of the oyster larvæ.
5. The spawning of oysters.
6. The destruction of seed oysters by oyster drills.
7. Pollution studies.
8. Administration and publications.

Space will not permit a detailed discussion of each of these subjects here; it will suffice to give merely the results obtained in most of the investigations, referring the reader for details to Bulletin 351, and the Report for 1920 and 1921, of the State Experiment Station. It seems advisable in our report to the Board of Shell Fisheries to lay emphasis on certain practical and economic phases of the work, rather than upon those of purely scientific interest.

SUMMARY OF RESULTS OF INVESTIGATIONS

1. *Studies of the rate and extent of growth of adult oysters.*

For these experiments, which were begun in April, 1919, and concluded in November, 1920, one thousand oysters fitted with numbered copper tags were weighed and measured prior to beginning the spring growth, at the close of the summer, and after one year. The percentage of increase in one year was as follows: Weight 66%, length 22%, width 26%. Of this total increase for the year there occurred during the spring and summer, April 1st to September 1st, an increase of 32% in weight, 19% in length and 22% in width, while during the autumn and winter, September 1st to March 30th, there occurred an increase of 34% in weight, 3% in length and 4% in width. It will be noted that by far the greater increase in length and width occurred with the addition of new shell during the spring and summer, while during the fall there was little addition of new shell but there was a marked increase in weight due to the enlargement of the shell cavity and increase in the size of the meat.

2. *Studies of yearly and seasonal variations in the food of the oyster.*

For the past two years, beginning September 1919, the oysters of Delaware Bay and of the New Jersey Coast have been unusually fat. Seldom have finer oysters left the beds in this State than those shipped during the fall of 1919 and of 1920. Coincident with this period of extreme fatness of oysters has been a great development of diatoms and other food organisms, notably a long filamentous diatom, *Melosira* which at times formed a veritable "soup" in the water. So abundant were the food organisms in Little Egg Harbor during the late summer of 1919 following a year of very lean oysters, that the biologist informed oyster shippers

of his belief that the fall season would find the oysters in excellent condition for market. The same prediction was made during the summer of 1920 with respect to the oysters of the New Jersey Coast and of Maurice River Cove. With the coming of autumn both years the predictions were more than justified by the very fat condition of the oysters.

Food conditions in New Jersey waters during the past summer, 1921, were not, in general, as good as during the two preceding years and indications are that on some of the beds, at least, oysters will be only fair or even poor this autumn.

Our endeavor is to establish a standard by means of which it will be possible to predict several months in advance the probable fatness of oysters during the shipping season, and what is of even more importance, to determine the fitness of a cleaned bed, or of a barren bottom for fattening transplanted oysters. Thus far it has been possible to predict, for two successive years, fat oysters, after finding an abundance of known food organisms in the water. It remains to be seen if in the absence of these known food organisms the oyster will be able to fatten on other organisms as yet unknown. We are very fortunate in having been able to procure the service of Professor G. W. Martin of the Botany Department of Rutgers College for a study of certain special phases of this problem.

3. *The influence of temperature, density, turbidity and other factors on the rate and extent of feeding of oysters.*

Observations extending over more than two years indicate that the oyster shows a "critical temperature" in its feeding activities. Above 44° F. oysters feed actively, while below 42° F. feeding is practically stopped, although very small amounts of food are taken in even as the temperature of the water falls to the freezing point. Data of much value both to science and to the practical oyster grower could be obtained if shippers would keep an accurate record of the water temperature each morning and evening at the floats, together with a record of the time the oysters are kept on the floats before they become freshened. Our observations indicate that this process would take place much more rapidly at temperatures above 44° F. than below 42° F.

Experiments on the influence of density, turbidity and other factors on the feeding of oysters are still in progress. A preliminary discussion of this subject appears in our report of 1920 to the State Experiment Station.

4. *Further investigations of the distribution and behavior of oyster larvæ.*

Investigations of the occurrence of oyster larvæ were carried on during the summer of 1920 both on the New Jersey Coast and in Delaware Bay. The results of the work on the Coast have been described in our report to the Experiment Station for this year and need not be repeated. The results of the investigations on Delaware Bay will be fully reported here.

The guard boat "Dianthus" served admirably for the work of procuring the straining samples of oyster larvæ, and her spacious cabin permitted microscopic work to be done on board, thus saving much time.

Oyster larvæ were abundant over the natural beds and the planted grounds from the middle of July to the middle of August. The largest number of larvæ taken in any one sample during the summer was 13,200 per hundred quarts of water, on Bed 510-C on July 14. A summary of the numbers of larvæ found, the density and temperature of the water is given in Table 1. (See Table 1)

Setting commenced on the natural grounds on July 27th and continued until about the middle of August. Examination of the natural beds on August 12th showed the extent of the set to be as follows: Main Cohansey bed, five quarts of shells gave three and one-half quarts without set; one and one-half quarts with set, total spat thirty-five. Bennies bed: seventy-eight shells taken at random forty-five without spat, thirty-three with spat, total spat 136. On lower Egg Island

bed and on New beds six shells each gave an average of four spat per shell for Egg Island bed, and eight spat on New beds. A heavy set occurred on some of the beds where shells were planted; 110-D showing an average of twenty-six spat per shell for shells with one or more spat; ground 239 yielding an average of 30 spat per shell on shells with one or more spat.

One very important result of the season's work in Delaware Bay was the discovery of the reactions of the oyster larvæ to the ebb and flow of the tides. It was found that the larvæ after they are about a week old tend to settle to the bottom during the ebb, and to rise during the flood; as a result of which they are carried by progressive stages upstream. Owing to these reactions to the tidal ebb and flow the oyster larvæ during their two weeks of free swimming existence are not lost at sea, but are carried back toward the headwaters. Were it not for these reactions of the larvæ the great natural beds of Delaware Bay never could have been established nor maintained. Vast numbers of the larvæ produced by the thousands of acres of planted oysters in Maurice River Cove are carried up the river and set on the Natural beds. (See Bulletin 351, New Jersey Experiment Station.)

5. The spawning of oysters.

The spawning of oysters was actually observed and has been described fully in Bulletin 351 and in our report for this year to the Experiment Station. Oysters in a group were found to spawn together, the females throwing out the eggs in great clouds, by snapping the shells together, while in the male the milt (Spermatozoa) issued into the water in a steady stream. Spawning was found to occur near the height of the flood tide with the incoming of water of higher density and of great purity. It is of interest to note in the early reports of Dr. Julius Nelson that his best results with artificial fertilization of oyster eggs occurred when water for the experiment was taken at high tide.

6. Destruction of seed oysters by drills.

The planted beds of Delaware Bay, free as they are from the inroads of starfish, and, save at rare intervals, of the drumfish, are, however, subject to the ravages of another and very important enemy. While its injurious effects are far less noticeable than are those of the "star" or of the "drum," they are, however, serious because continuous and often overlooked. The small oyster drill, *Urosalpinx cinerea*, is a curse of the first magnitude to the planted beds of Delaware Bay. Examination on October 7th, in section A and B, of spat which set about two months previous, showed from 33% to 50% drilled. On September 7th, 1920, examination of the natural beds at the mouth of the Mullica River showed 71% of the season's set already drilled.

Such an insidious enemy, working continuously, must make most serious inroads in the young seed oysters, both those which set upon the beds, and those transplanted thither from the natural grounds. Experiments are now under way to construct if possible an inexpensive tray which will capture the drills.

7. Pollution studies.

In cooperation with the State Department of Health a brief survey was made October 21-22, 1920, to determine to what extent pollution by sewage and industrial wastes from the upper Delaware were coming down into the waters covering the natural beds of Delaware Bay.

Two cross sectional studies were made at dead low water; the first from Ship John Light to the mouth of the Cohansey, the second from Arnolds Point Shoals to the mouth of Stow Creek. This brief survey failed to show evidence of serious pollution on the natural beds of upper Delaware Bay.

8. Administration and publications.

During September, 1920, the biologist attended, at his own expense, the National Convention of the American Public Health Association at San Francisco,

California, and presented a paper to the Laboratory Section entitled, "Some Aspects of Pollution as Affecting Oyster Propagation." Advantage was taken of the opportunity while there of investigating conditions for oyster culture on the Pacific Coast, and prominent oyster growers, members of the California Fish and Game Commission, scientists and others interested in oyster culture, were interviewed.

The biologist also attended the annual meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Science at Chicago, in December, 1920. Two papers, with stereoptician illustrations, were presented: one before the American Society of Zoologists, entitled, "Observations of the Feeding Habits of Oysters," the second, presented to the Ecological Society of America, was entitled "Studies of the Distribution and Behavior of Oyster Larvæ."

In May, 1921, the writer was called to Providence, Rhode Island, to give testimony as to the effect of oil upon oysters in the case of Rooks vs. The Mexican Petroleum Company. Although evidence of an unquestionable character was presented to show that oil was responsible for the death of the oysters on the beds, verdict was rendered for the defendant.

The biologist has been appointed as Chairman of a Committee of the Ecological Society of America on Pollution of Inland and Coastal Waters. On June 16th, at the invitation of Secretary Hoover of the Department of Commerce, he attended a conference called to discuss problems of pollution and conversation as applied to fisheries. He was appointed by the Secretary of Commerce as a member of a permanent committee on pollution of which Mr. Kenneth Fowler of the American Fisheries Association is Chairman.

On June 17th, the writer, at the invitation of the United States Bureau of Fisheries, attended an informal discussion of problems concerned with experimental oyster culture, held at the office of the Deputy Commissioner in Washington. This was the third annual meeting of its kind which has thus far been held, and was designed to bring about closer cooperation between the Bureau of Fisheries and investigators of the several oyster producing states who are engaged in research on oyster problems. The Bureau, by thus coordinating research conducted in various states and serving as a clearing house for data collected, is rendered a valuable service to our Department.

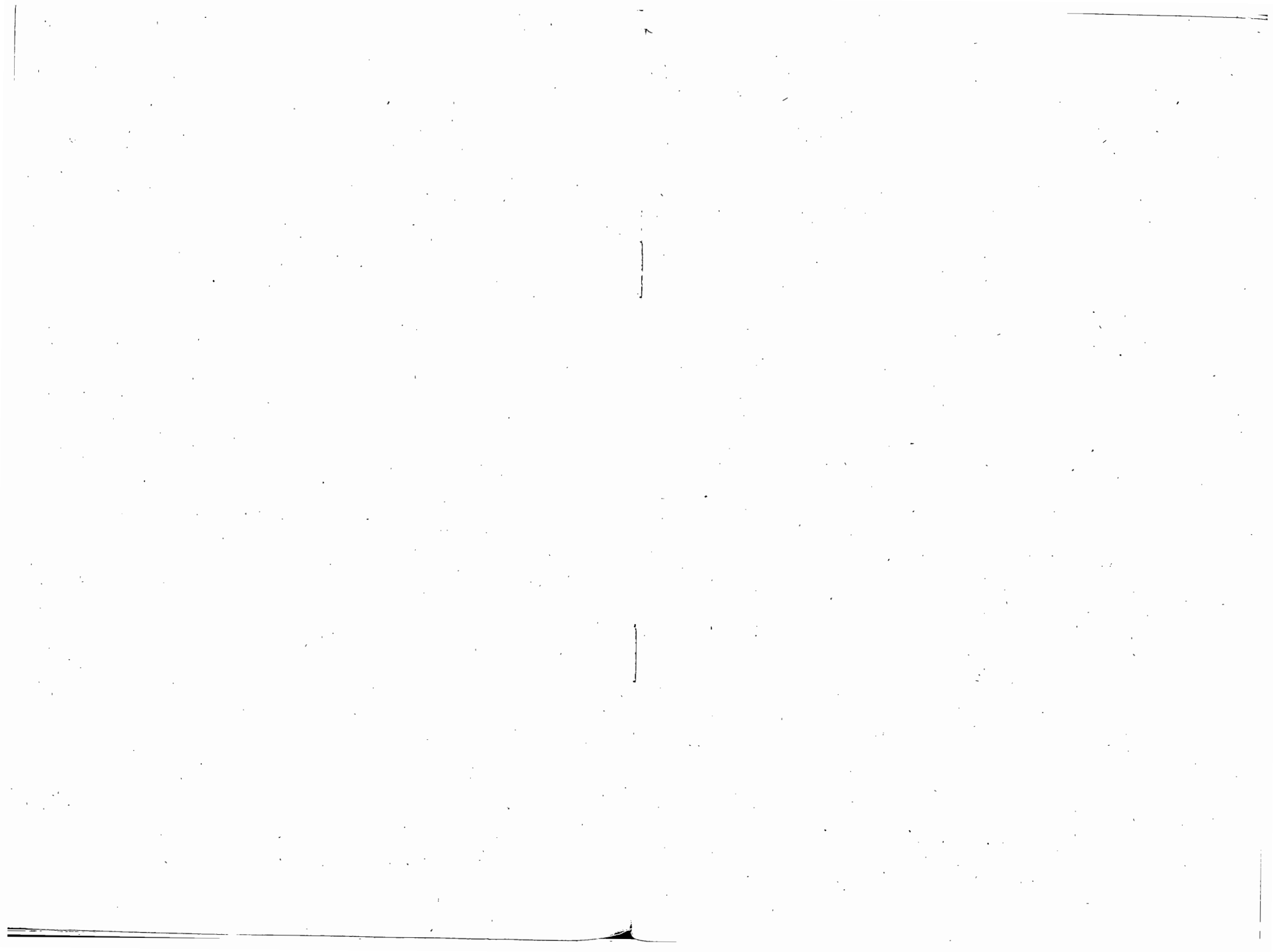
