Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

Aviation Department

The region's YTD September passenger traffic grew 4.5%, virtually unchanged from the first half results despite a 3.9% increase in ticket prices. Factors contributing to the sustained passenger growth included a mild winter compared to blizzard conditions a year ago, a leap year this February, record-breaking passenger growth in August and stronger pace of economic growth in January and February. As a result, YTD domestic traffic gained 4.6% and international traffic grew 4.3%. Cargo continues to remain weak as the YTD Sept. level fell 6.5%. Due to the continued weakness, we anticipate that the magnitude of the 2012 cargo decline well probably be larger than the 4% decline predicted for this year.
