A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to water-front construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

April 30--SEWERAGE GRANTS IN MONMOUTH, MORRIS COUNTIES--Acting Governor Joseph Merlino announced three sewerage grants from the Clean Waters Bond Act of 1976, totaling \$772,392. They are: Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority, \$758,464 for expansion of a treatment plant to serve Keansburg, Keyport and Matawan, Monmouth County; Middletown Township Sewerage Authority, Monmouth County, \$3,800 to plan on alternatives to ocean dumping of sludge, and Hanover Sewerage Authority, Morris County, \$10,128 to prepare a wastewater facilities plan. The grants, administered by DEP, represent eight percent of project costs. Seventy five percent is funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and 17 percent locally.

May 1--RADIATION SURVEY AT ORANGE--A survey of radiation at the site of the former U.S. Radium Corporation plant at 420-26 Alden Street, Orange, was resumed to determine what steps will be needed to remedy residual radiation contamination. DEP's Bureau of Radiation Protection and the EPA are making the survey where radium was refined and incorporated into various products between 1917 and 1929. Several small businesses unrelated to the former facility now occupy the site.

May 2--DEP CERTIFIES \$2.1 MILLION IN SEWER GRANT APPLICATIONS--Four sewer grant applications totaling \$2.1 million were certified by DEP. They have been forwarded to EPA for 75 percent grant awards. They are: Trenton, \$1.5 million to convert South Clinton Avenue trunk sewer to a storm drain by building separate sanitary sewers; Stafford Municipal Utilities Authority, Ocean County, \$404,700 to design a wastewater collection system; Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority, \$172,413 for plans for future construction of sludge dewatering facilities, and the Bergen County Utilities Authority, \$72,795 to prepare plans for future construction of sludge dewatering facilities.

May 3--DIRECTOR FOR PINELANDS ACQUISITION--Howard Wolf, formerly deputy director of the Green Acres Program, has been named special assistant in charge of DEP's Pinelands acquisition program. He will coordinate the Pinelands real estate function of DEP, according to Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson.

May 3--LOW INCOME HOUSING APPROVED IN ATLANTIC CITY--DEP's Division of Marine Services has approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit allowing conversion of a former vocational school building at Arctic and Illinois avenues, Atlantic City, into an apartment building. Sencit Company, of Elizabeth, proposes to complete 66 one, two and three-room apartments for tenants of low or moderate incomes.

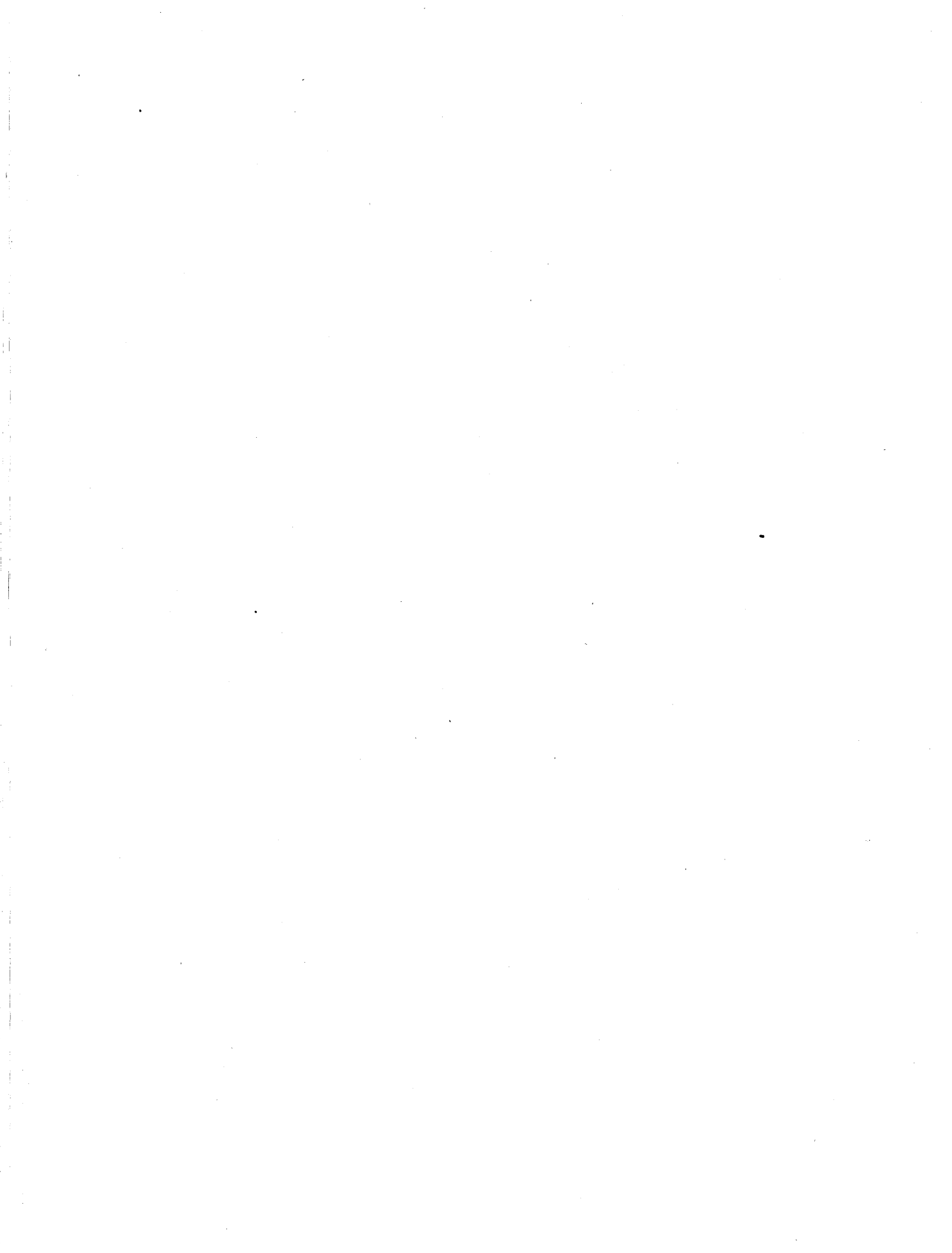
