Governor To Spend Monday in Monmouth County; Sign Legislation to Expand Reach of KidCare Program

Gov. Christie Whitman on Monday will sign legislation expanding the reach of KidCare, the health insurance program for New Jersey children. The Governor will sign the legislation as part of a day long tour of Monmouth County. The Governor will also participate in the unveiling of the US Postal Service Stamp commemorating Vietnam War Veterans.

Later in the day, the Governor will tour the new train station in Aberdeen. The governor will also present two checks during the tour; one to Monmouth County Freeholders representing state aid to the county and the other to help the Deal Lake Commission restore the lake.

Residents in Red Bank and Keansburg are encouraged to come out and meet the Governor as she tours local spots. The Governor recently spent the day touring Bergen County and rode her bike down the Jersey shoreline two weeks ago.

On Saturday, the Governor will serve as the Grand Marshall in the "Night in Venice" parade in Ocean City. On Sunday, the Governor will attend the Gloucester County Fair and Peach Festival.
