RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
APRIL 1997

Comparing counts for April 30, 1997 with those on April 30, 1996, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

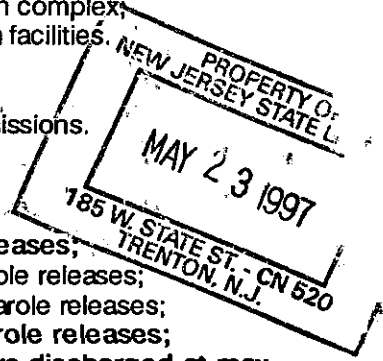
- 2% increase from 27,052 to 27,585 for the jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- -2% decrease from 4,721 to 4,619 for county waiting;
- -2% decrease from 1,031 to 1015 for county contract and county assistance;
- 6% increase from 15,984 to 16,921 for the prison complex;
- -5% decrease from 5,316 to 5,030 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

- 25% increase from 1,225 to 1,536 for total admissions.

RELEASES

- 7% increase from 1,347 to 1,443 for total releases;
- -1% decrease from 1,034 to 1,028 for male parole releases;
- 36% increase from 75 to 102 for female parole releases;
- 2% increase from 1,109 to 1,130 for total parole releases;
- 32% increase from 238 to 313 for offenders discharged at max.



NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ **DISCHARGE AT MAX** includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.
