RESOLUTION #2-Item C
EXEMPTION REPORT
NEW JERSEY FIRST ACT

WHEREAS, P.L.2011 Chapter 70 ("New Jersey First Act") was signed into law on May 19, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this law requires individuals to be residents of New Jersey in order to hold certain public employee positions in the State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that full-time members of the faculty,

administrative and support staff will be exempt from the residency provision of the law if they resided outside of the State of New Jersey prior to September 1, 2011, or, if the position/title of a full or part-time members of the administrative and support staff is included in an exemption report filed by Passaic County Community College with the State by November 1, 2011, and on January 1 annually thereafter; and

WHEREAS, inclusion of positions on the exemption report is based on the requirement of the position for special expertise or extraordinary qualifications in an academic, scientific, technical, professional, or medical field or in administration, which if not exempt from the residency requirement, would seriously impede the College's ability to compete successfully with higher education institutions in other states; and

WHEREAS, in order to exempt the aforementioned reference positions/titles from the residency requirements of the New Jersey First Act, the College must file an exemption report with the State by November 1, 2011 and on January 1 annually thereafter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President of the College to file the attached Exemption Report with the appropriate State officials by November 1, 2011; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President of the College to file amended Exemption Reports, as appropriate, to add new or modified positions/titles to respond to the changing needs of the College and file it with the State.
