LIBRARY

LEGAL BASIS FOR PUBLIC SERVICE IN NEW JERSEY

AREA LIBRARY:

A headquarters library under contract with the State for specialized services to libraries within a given geographic area. There are 24 Area Libraries indicated in the tables by an asterisk (*) before the library name.

ASSOCIATION LIBRARY:

One established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. There are 101 association libraries. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the use of the public are included in this publication. Some libraries formerly listed as association libraries are now branches or stations of their county library. Association libraries are identified under the column headed "Type" in the accompanying tables by an "A".

COUNTY LIBRARY:

One established by law following a county-wide referendum passed by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission composed of 5 members appointed by the Freeholders. There are 13 county libraries identified under column headed "Type" by a "C".

FEDERATION:

Any number of independently established libraries voluntarily united to develop cooperative free public library services. Each member library retains complete institutional independence but enters into contracts or service agreements with other members to achieve the joint services agreed upon by the governing bodies of the respective libraries. There are two federations of libraries in New Jersey whose members retain identity as municipal libraries.

JOINT LIBRARY:

One established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities. There are three joint libraries identified under column headed "Type" by a "J".

MUNICIPAL LIBRARY:

One established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a 7 member board appointed by the mayor which must include the mayor and the superintendent of schools. There are 208 municipal libraries identified under column headed "Type" by an "M".

REGIONAL LIBRARY:

One established by law following resolution adopted by the boards of chosen freeholders of 2 or more counties. It is governed by a board of trustees appointed by the boards of freeholders of the participating counties. There are no regional libraries to date.

NOTES ON STATISTICS

These statistics are compiled from reports submitted by individual libraries for calendar year 1972. Additional data and processing has been supplied as indicated below. Where a library is substantially supported by more than one municipality, figures shown represent combined municipalities. Salary tables are derived from reported salary of director and beginning professional for 1972.

Library Name	Generally the municipality name identifies a public library. Where a library name differs from that of the municipality, the library name is inserted in parenthesis under the name of the municipality.
Estimated Population Served	Source: New Jersey Population Estimates — 1972 by New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry, Office of Business Economics. Total population of New Jersey as of July, 1972, was estimated at 7,382,985. Population served by local libraries is somewhat less at 7,266,365. <u>The remainder of the population, or 116,620 reside in unserved municipalities of counties without a county library.</u>
Equalized Valuation	Source: Table of Equalized Valuation by New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Taxation — 1972 Conformed Copy. Figures are shown to the nearest thousand. Equalized Valuation of unserved municipalities not included in tables.
Local Tax Support	Tax support is shown as reported by individual libraries. Calculation of State Aid is made on basis of expended and reserved amounts shown in line item for the library of the municipal budget. County library taxes shown here as local tax support for county libraries.
Per Capita State Aid	Amounts shown represent State Aid sent in October, 1972, to municipalities supporting local libraries. County total represents the entire amount of Per Capita State Aid in return for local official support of libraries. Some county totals are larger than the sum for the libraries listed. State Aid to Area Libraries, Research Libraries and Incentive Grants are not shown in this column.
Per Capita Expenditures	Derived from total expenditures as reported by libraries divided by the estimated population served as shown in tables. For county member libraries, per capita expenditures including library dedicated tax is also computed and shown although the library services are provided locally through county library expenditures.
Staff	<p>Figures appearing under column Professional Certified represent individual librarians who hold New Jersey Certification. Under <i>Employed Full Time</i>, the number of individuals working on a full time basis for a minimum of 30 hours per week is reported (as of December 1972). Figures appearing under column headed Total in Full Time Equivalents represent the addition of part time help and the full time people averaged for the entire year.</p> <p>Number of volunteers working on a non-paid basis are shown under column headed "Vol".</p>
Volumes Owned	Figure represents books reported as owned at the end of 1972. Other materials which are prepared, cataloged and recorded in the same manner as books are also reported here. In the case of county member libraries books reported as supplied by the County Library on extended long term loan are included here.
Subscribed Periodicals	Figure shows reported number of titles under Subscription including newspapers and magazines other than annuals at end of 1972.
Hours Open Per Week	The number of hours the main library was open for public service during the major part of 1972 is shown. Figures appearing under Totals represent averages for the county or State.
Per Capita Books In Library	Derived from volumes reported in library divided by estimated population served.
Unreported Items	Where information requested of a reporting library was not provided, N.R. is inserted in the column to indicate Not Reported. Libraries failing to submit a report are indicated by No Report Received.

Tabulations of current statistics concerning Budget Allocations are enclosed. Response by library directors to the mailed questionnaire has been gratifying. 73% of the public libraries had returned the completed questionnaires in time to be included in these tabulations.

All three of the tables that follow are taken from the "Budget by Categories" questionnaire. This represents budget - not expenditure - as presented on the questionnaires. The tables are titled as follows:

Table 1 - Budgets of 237 Public Libraries for 1973 by library.

Table 2 - Percentage of Total Budget Allocated to Salaries/Wages, Materials and Other Expenses - by County - 1971-72-73.

Table 3 - Detailed Percentage Distribution by Regions.

(In Tables 2 and 3, in order to make a comparison with previous years, percentages are used, since in 1973 only a 73% sample is represented in the absolute figures. Salaries and Wages are steadily increasing as a percent of total budget - from 64.4% in 1967 to 68.0% in 1973. The percent of budget for materials has remained at 20%, or slightly less, in the years since 1967 for all New Jersey Public Libraries.)
