- Public hearing topic "GLOBAL WARMING POLLUTANTS IN NEW JERSEY: Beyond carbon dioxide" re: speakers, finalizing brochure, and coordination discussed.
- Discussion of potential speakers for February meeting; Covanta confirmed. LEAP students from Camden may Skype if available. More information will be provided in February's agenda.

Administrative Report

1. **Update on VW Mitigation Trust** - The Beneficiary Mitigation Plan was finalized on December 13, 2018 and submitted to the Trust. DAQ is currently reviewing 157 projects requesting \$491 million. Funding requests may be submitted 30 days after the submission of the BMP. The first funding request will be for Electric Vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure.
2. **Transportation and Climate Initiative Low Carbon Transportation Future** -- On December 19, 2018, nine states (Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia) and the District of Columbia announced a plan to design a regional cap-and-invest approach to cap transportation greenhouse gas emissions. The states said they will spend the next year designing a cap-and-trade program under the umbrella of the Transportation and Climate Initiative (TCI), a program housed at the Georgetown Climate Center. 3. **New Jersey Proposes Ozone State Implementation Plan Revision (Updated)** – On December 17, 2018 Air Quality held a public hearing on for the proposed State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision related to the 2015 Ozone and 2008 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). There were no comments received during the hearing. The comment period closed December 21, 2018 with comments received USEPA Region 2 and the State of Connecticut

The proposed SIP revision includes three components:

- Certification that New Jersey has the ability and authority to implement, maintain, and enforce the 2015 8-hour 70 ppb ozone NAAQS, addressing the infrastructure requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act (CAA) Sections 110(a)(1) and (2).
- Addressing the interstate transport requirements of Section 110(a)(2)(D)(i)(I) of the CAA and commonly known as the "Good Neighbor" SIP for both the 70 ppb and the 75 ppb 8-hour ozone NAAQS.
- A negative declaration that the Oil and Natural Gas Control Technique Guidelines (CTGs) do not pertain to New Jersey.
