## Teterboro & regional satellite airport summaries

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region dodges a bullet -- Absence of promised terrorism boosts travel confidence. Region's passenger traffic down (1.4%) compared to American Transport Association (ATA) average of negative (5.5%). Regional freight traffic is up 8.2% well ahead of the ATA average.
