THE POLICY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY WITH REFERENCE  
TO THE APPROVAL OF SEWER EXTENSIONS TO BE  
CONSTRUCTED IN ONE MUNICIPALITY AND TO  
DISCHARGE INTO THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF A  
SECOND MUNICIPALITY

It is the policy of the Department to require that applications for the approval of plans and other engineering data for sewer extensions be approved by the owner of the sewer system or sewage treatment plant into which the proposed extensions would discharge. The policy is based upon the premise that the Department in its supervision over the operation of sewage treatment plants and its control over the pollution of the waters of this State, particularly in the enforcement of R. S. 58:12-1 et seq., must concern itself with the owner of the sewer system or sewage treatment plant discharging an effluent into the waters of this State.
