Open enrollment under the Get Covered NJ State Marketplace begins November 1, 2024. By state law, New Jersey residents are required to obtain medical insurance.

Key Points

- **Enrollment for 2025 begins on November 1, 2024.**
- New Jersey uses a State-based Marketplace, **Get Covered NJ.**
- **Special enrollment is possible at any time of year if you have a qualifying life event or if you qualify for NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid and CHIP).**

Important dates for 2025 enrollment

- **November 1, 2024 - Enrollment period starts**
- **January 31, 2025 - Enrollment period ended**
- **If you enroll by December 31, your coverage will start on January 1. If you enroll in January, your coverage will start on February 1**

Beginning January 1, 2019, New Jersey requires state residents to maintain health insurance.

Special Enrollment

Special Enrollment Outside of Enrollment Dates

Special enrollment is possible **if you have a qualifying life event** outside of the open enrollment period.

You can enroll in or change plans if you have certain life changes or qualify for NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid and CHIP).

Qualifying Life Events

Include:

- Marriage/Divorce
- Losing other health coverage
- Having a baby
- Adopting a child
- Turning 26 and losing coverage through a parent's plan
- Becoming a U.S. citizen
- Moved to a new residence
- Leaving incarceration
- Others
